

ENGLISH LITERATURE GLOSSARY OF LITERARY DEVICES AND TERMS

Since certain words, terms, and categories overlap in literary analysis due to how closely related they are, it is important to consider the following general definitions:

FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE: The deliberate transformation of ordinary language (words, sounds, or phrases) to heighten the reader's reading experience. It includes a wide range of literary devices and strategies. Figure of speech is a broad umbrella term for any type of figurative language where a word means more than its literal sense.

LITERARY DEVICES: Specific techniques chosen by writers to convey deeper meaning and complexity in their work. The main ones studied in literary analysis – whether short stories, novels, or poetry – are included in this glossary in alphabetical order. Examples: hyperbole – imagery

ALLEGORY: When concrete elements (such as the plot, characters, places, and objects) reveal hidden meanings and explain abstract, philosophical, moral, or political concepts. An allegory proposes two different levels of analysis, the surface level and the symbolic one. For example, the novel Lord of the Files by William Golding tells the story of a group of boys stranded on an island [literal interpretation], but it can also be read as an allegory for the dark side of human nature [figurative interpretation].

2. ALLUSION: A reference, within a text, to other ideas, people, or events. An allusion can be implied, indirect or direct, and can refer to a historical, mythical, or literary person, place, event, or movement. They are used by writers to compress a great deal of significance within their original text since they enrich the content with additional references. Since literary allusions are not explained, they rely on the reader's ability to identify and comprehend references without advanced academic or literary knowledge. In Western literature, common literary allusions are to the Bible or Greco-Roman Mythology.

3. AMBIGUITY: The possibility of two or more interpretations. This literary device (sometimes called double entendred lends itself to double meanings, enabling readers to reflect and broaden their knowledge on a subject by contemplating unclear or deliberately vague sentences, passages, and works.

4. ANALOGY: Used to make arguments or reinforce ideas by elaborating comparisons or parallels. Different from simile and metaphor, analogies tend to be longer as they propose similarities between what is seemingly different. The following analogy explains how the mystery of the universe can never be solved: "If you want my final opinion on the mystery of life and all that, I can give it to you in a nutshell. The universe is like a safe to which there is a combination. But the combination is locked up in the safe". — Peter De Vries, Let Me Count the Ways.

5. ANAPHORA: The repetition of a word or words at the beginning of successive phrases, clauses, or lines. Used for emphasis in political speeches, songs, poems, stories, novels, and plays: "In every cry of every Man, / In every Infants cry of fear, / In every voice: in every ban, / The mind-forg'd manacles I hear." — William Blake, London LITERARY TERMS: A variety of terms and words employed in the study and interpretation of literary works. Examples: genre – theme – plot – character

RHETORICAL DEVICES: Linguistic tools and techniques used for oral and written communication purposes. When literary devices are employed to persuade or appeal to the reader, they are identified as rhetorical devices. On the other hand, when the primary focus is not to persuade, but to express ideas skilfully and eloquently, figurative language is the preferred term.

6. ANTICLIMAX: While a climax is a logical and satisfying conclusion to the excitement, tension, or turning point in the plot, an anticlimax is the very opposite. This literary device underscores disappointment as expectations are unfulfilled due to a random, accidental, or less exciting outcome.

7. ANTITHESIS: By placing two contrary ideas, words, or clauses with opposite meanings in parallel structure and in proximity, antithesis draws attention to both. Some famous examples: "To err is human; to forgive divine." — Alexander Pope / "Better to reign in Hell, than serve in Heav'n." — John Milton / "One small step for man, one giant leap for mankind." — Neil Armstrong.

8. APOSTROPHE: Used to address someone or something absent as if they were present. An apostrophe may be an abstract, imaginary, or absent person or object, as in Frankenstein's declaration: "Oh! Stars and Clouds and winds, ye are all about to mock me..." — Mary Shelley

9. ARCHETYPE: Timeless aspects of literature that embody human experiences consistently enough to become universal concepts. Archetypes can be situations (ex: a quest), storylines (ex: the hero's journey), themes (ex: good vs evil), or symbols (ex: fire vs ice) that share recurring patterns and identifiable traits, making them recognizable to all cultures independent of time or place. Several common character archetypes appear in literary works and in film such as the hero, the explorer, the sage, the rebel, the femme fatale, and the star-crossed lovers. The contributions of psychologist Carl Jung, known for his work on the collective unconscious, and literary theorist Northrop Frye's examination of symbolic patterns are key to understanding archetypes which can be found in dreams, myths, and fairytales.

10. BALLAD: A form of poetry that tells a story. The earliest ballads in English were originally folk tales and legends, sung and passed down from one generation to another. Ballads (also known as narrative poems) were popular among the Romantic poets.

11. CARPE DIEM: From the Latin "seize the day", the belief that the fleeting nature of life should incite us to live life to the fullest, notably by embracing the pleasures of the moment. Poems that urge the reader to sayour every life experience.
