A Fool's Errand Albion Winegar Tourgee, 1969 Ragtime in the White House Eliot Vestner, 2020-06-16 History played a trick on McKinley He has been consigned to the shadows between Lincoln and Theodore Roosevelt vilified or ignored by historians It is a richly undeserved fate As Eliot Vestner demonstrates in this narrative of the political life of William McKinley there was much more to the twenty fifth president s tenure in office than history books allow He was a popular president winning a second term with ease But only nine months into it he was assassinated by a self described anarchist What more he might have accomplished is anyone s guess He had managed to successfully pull America out of one of the worst economic depressions yet experienced the Panic of 1893 And his controversial tariffs strengthened industry and contributed to the overall wealth of the country as did his return of the country to the gold standard He also led the U S to victory in the Spanish American war and implemented the first steps toward building the Panama Canal which his successor Theodore Roosevelt continued Perhaps the most under appreciated aspect of McKinley's presidency was his advocacy for black civil rights and his challenge to the white supremacy of the south As governor of Ohio he fought against lynching He signed a ground breaking antilynching bill Ironically as president he had a much more difficult time combating violence and racial injustice because of the use of states rights as justification for voter suppression and terrorism towards blacks He pursued opportunities to advance the interests of black Americans wherever he could but his inability to stop the lynchings and disfranchisement of blacks was most regrettable His successors had no interest in the race issue which remained unresolved until the 1954 court decision in Brown v The Board of Education This book gives McKinley his due and thereby helps us better understand a President of the United States whose work has seemingly been overlooked by most Americans Peace in the US Republic of Letters, 1840-1900 Sandra M. Gustafson, 2023-09-06 Peace in the US Republic of today Letters 1840 1900 explores the early peace movement as it captured the imagination of leading writers The book charts the rise of the peace cause from its sources in the works of William Penn and John Woolman through the founding of the first peace societies in 1815 and the mid century peace congresses to the postbellum movement's consequential emphasis on arbitration The Civil War is the central axis for the book with three chapters organized around readings of novels by James Fenimore Cooper Harriet Beecher Stowe and Nathaniel Hawthorne spanning the period from 1840 to 1865 Cooper had personal connections to the movement and thought deeply about the issues it addressed Literary interest in peace at times overlapped with abolitionism as was true for Stowe And in the case of Hawthorne attention to peace advocacy arose out of a mixture of skepticism regarding perfectionist impulses a desire to explore the nature and limits of violence and fear of civil conflict The volume also explores fiction engaged with problems that arose in the aftermath of that war including novels by Henry Adams and John Hay on political corruption and class conflict works on the failures of Reconstruction by Albion Tourg e and Charles Chesnutt and the varied treatments of Indigenous experience in Helen Hunt Jackson's Ramona and Simon
