A Guide to the World's Languages Merritt Ruhlen, 1991 This is the first of three pathbreaking volumes that will constitute a wide ranging analytical guide to the world's approximately 5 000 languages The volumes are written for both linguists and general readers and this first volume in particular assumes no background in linguistics A postscript prepared for this paperback edition takes research data to 1990 The book is illustrated with 21 maps *An Introduction to the Languages of the World* Anatole Lyovin, 1997 This text is designed to introduce students to the variety of languages of the world *A Grammar of Yéli Dnye* Stephen C. Levinson, 2022-06-06 This is a comprehensive description of a language spoken some 450 km offshore from the mainland of Papua New Guinea The language is remarkable for its phonological morphological and syntactic complexity As the sole surviving member of its language family and with little historical contact with surrounding languages the language provides evidence of the kind of languages spoken in this part of the world before the Austronesian expansion The grammar provides detailed information on the phoneme inventory morphology syntax and select semantic fields Remarkable features include a 90 phoneme inventory including unique sounds a morphology with thousands of non compositional portmanteau elements complex rules for negation and extensive ergative syntax Unusual patterns are also found in the organization of semantic fields for example in paronymies of the body taxonomies of the natural world verbal semantics and kinship terms The combination of linguistic rara suggest that linguistic evolution under low contact can yield baroque and unusual patterns The volume should be of special interest to linguists typologists sociolinguists anthropologists and researchers in Oceania and Melanesia Endorsement This long awaited grammar is a major contribution to Papuan and general linguistics providing as it does by far the most comprehensive and accurate grammatical description of a language that has already assumed a position as one of the world's most complicated Hitherto the most extensive grammatical description of the language has been the survey like Henderson 1995 and while Levinson explicitly acknowledges his debt to this earlier grammar and to unpublished work by Henderson his own detailed grammar clearly takes the level of description and analysis of the language to a completely new level In particular Levinson's grammar makes clear precisely to what extent and in what ways the language's morphology is complex beyond even what most studies on morphologically complex languages envisage In addition it provides a much more detailed account of the language's syntax based on a judicious combination of corpus attestation and careful elicitation incl using the kits developed by Levinson's group at the MPI for Psycholinguistics The grammar thus not only fills a major lacuna in our knowledge of the non Austronesian languages of the New Guinea area but also provides grist for future studies on the implications of the language's complexities Bernard Comrie University of California Santa Barbara **Semitic Languages** Gideon Goldenberg, 2013-01-10 This book offers a thorough authoritative account of the branches of Semitic among them Akkadian Aramaic Hebrew Arabic and Ethiopic It describes their history from ancient times to the present geographical distribution writing systems classification linguistic features

Imaginary Languages Marina Yaguello, 2023-09-19 An exploration of the practice of inventing languages from speaking in tongues to utopian schemes of universality to the discoveries of modern linguistics In *Imaginary Languages* Marina Yaguello explores the history and practice of inventing languages from religious speaking in tongues to politically utopian schemes of universality to the discoveries of modern linguistics She looks for imagined languages that are autonomous systems complete unto themselves and meant for communal use imaginary and therefore unlike both natural languages and historically attested languages and products of an individual effort to lay hold of language Inventors of languages Yaguello writes are madly in love they love an object that belongs to them only to the extent that they also share it with a community Yaguello investigates the sources of imaginary languages in myths dreams and utopias She takes readers on a tour of languages invented in literature from the sixteenth to the twentieth century including that in More's *Utopia* Leibniz's algebra of thought and Bulwer Lytton's linguistic fiction She examines the linguistic fantasies or madness of Georgian linguist Nikolai Marr and Swiss medium H l ne Smith and considers the quest for the true philosophical language Yaguello finds two abiding and somewhat contradictory forces the diversity of linguistic experience which stands opposed to unifying endeavors and on the other hand features shared by all languages natural or not and their users which justifies the universalist hypothesis Recent years have seen something of a boom in invented languages whether artificial languages meant to facilitate international communication or imagined languages constructed as part of science fiction worlds In *Imaginary Languages* an updated and expanded version of the earlier *Les Fous du langage* published in English as *Lunatic Lovers of Language* Yaguello shows that the invention of language is above all a passionate dizzying labor
