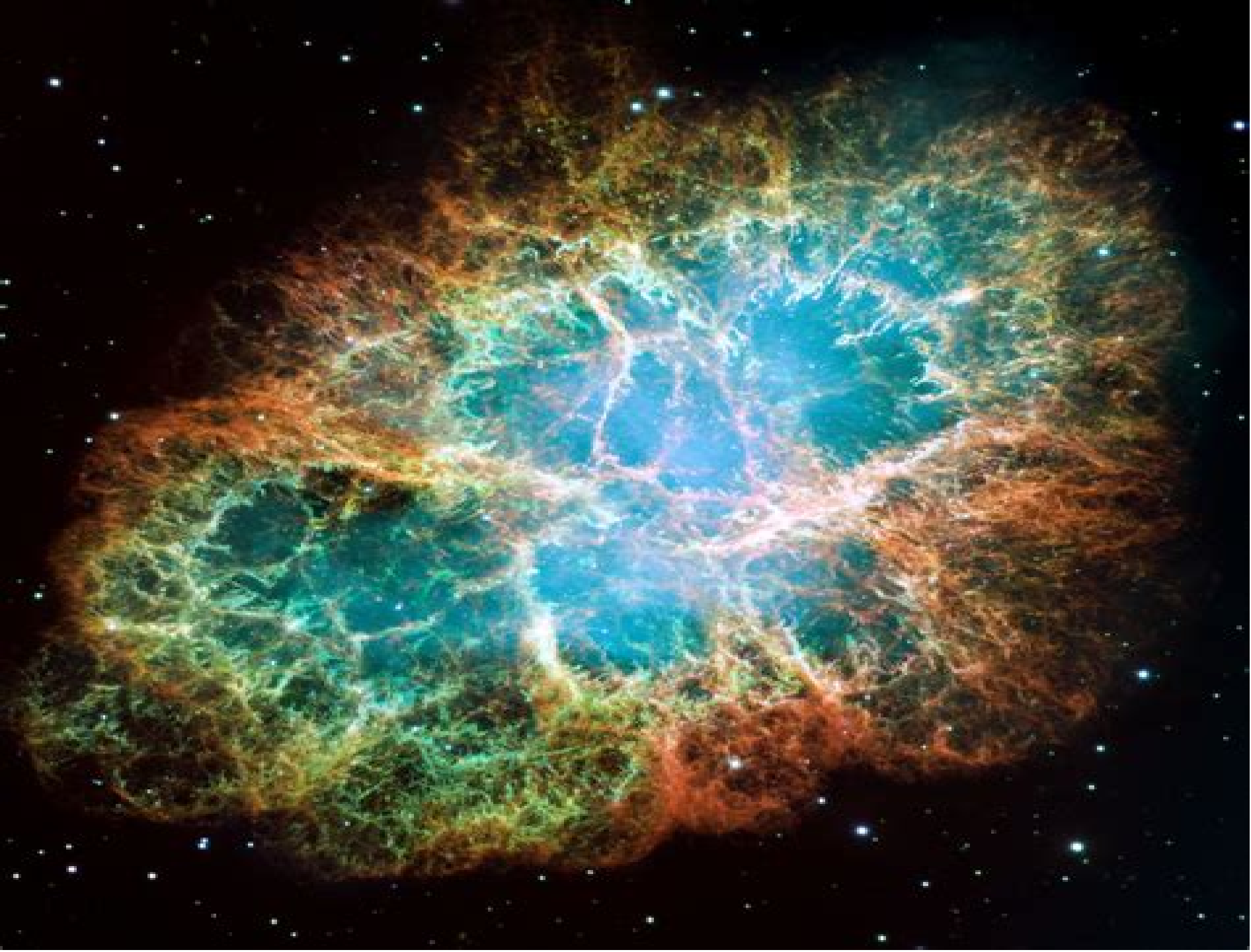

The Crab Nebula Simon Mitton, 1979 The Crab Nebula R.D. Davies, F.G. Smith, 2012-12-06 The Symposium on the Crab Nebula was held in the University of Manchester from 5 to 7 August 1970 The meetings on the first day were held in the Physics Department on the University campus and on the second and third days at the Nuffield Radio Astronomy Laboratories Jodrell Bank The 4th Symposium of the International Astronomical Union convened in the University and at Jodrell Bank fifteen years earlier 25-27 August 1955 dealt with the entire subject of radio and radar astronomy Now the subject matter of this 46th Symposium of the International Astronomical Union was confined to one single object It is interesting to recall that even at the 1955 symposium the Crab Nebula figured prominently In particular J H Oort described the new measurements of the polarization of the light from the nebula and I S Shklovsky explained the light and radio emission in terms of the motion of relativistic electrons in the magnetic field of the nebula No one could have foreseen the exciting discoveries of a decade later which stimulated the assembly of 172 participants to this 1970 Symposium In addition to the lectures and discussions the visitors were able to tour the laboratories and telescopes at Jodrell Bank to see the various researches in progress The demonstrations included a real time display on a cathode ray tube of the pulses from pulsar CP 0328 received in the 250 ft steerable telescope **Supernovae** Paul Murdin, Lesley Murdin, 1985-11-07 This revised 1985 edition tells the story of supernovae capturing the flavour of ancient astronomy **The Physical Universe** Frank Shu, 1982 THE PHYSICAL UNIVERSE An Introduction to Astronomy by Frank Shu is a classic text that despite its age still offers up concise and exact explanations of concepts in physics from basic thermodynamics and quantum up to solar and galactic physics and on to cosmology The philosophical ruminations on life not only add to this book's depth but also to its basic sense of humanity Nuclear Science Abstracts, 1976 Exploring the X-Ray Universe Philip A. This book reports on the extraordinary observation of TeV gamma rays from the Crab Pulsar the most energetic light ever detected from this type of object It presents detailed information on the painstaking analysis of the unprecedentedly large dataset from the MAGIC telescopes and comprehensively discusses the implications of pulsed TeV gamma rays for state of the art pulsar emission models Using these results the book subsequently explores new testing methodologies for Lorentz Invariance Violation in terms of a wavelength dependent speed of light The book also covers an updated search for Very High Energy VHE 100 GeV emissions from millisecond pulsars using the Large Area Telescope on board the Fermi satellite as well as a study on the promising Pulsar Wind Nebula candidate PSR J0631 The observation of VHE gamma rays is essential to studying the non thermal sources of radiation in our Universe Rotating neutron stars also known as pulsars are an extreme source class known to emit VHE gamma rays However to date only two pulsars have been detected with emissions above 100 GeV and our understanding of their emission mechanism is still lacking
