

UNDERSTANDING FIRE IN ALCHEMY

Earth is the basis for all you do. Water underlies the reality of earth, air is the consciousness that allows you to follow your emotions – and then comes the fourth element, fire.

Earth to stand on, water to drink, and air to breathe: these are more or less constants in life. Fire, on the other hand, glows from the sky in the form of the Sun and the millions of other stars, but it does not exist with you. You can kindle fire, but you can't touch it and sooner or later it dies away. Fire is ephemeral; even the Sun will burn out in time.

The energy of life

As long as fire burns – and for as long as a flame lives – fire is pure energy. Fire needs something of earth to consume, but it cannot be buried. Fire needs air to burn, but it cannot survive a strong wind. Fire does not need water to live – and is in fact doused by it – but fire can make water rise into the air as steam. Fire is fundamentally different to the other three elements, but it is the essential fourth. The other elements are eternal – only fire has a birth and a death. In alchemy, only fire experiences what you would call 'life'.

Fire is a dynamic, living element. It is not constant like earth, air and water. Fire represents the spark between birth and death, it is pure and untamed life energy.
