The Watsons of Kilconnor, County Carlow, 1650 - present Peter J F Coutts, Alan Watson, 2019-02 This book describes the history of a humble family that migrated from England to Ireland in the mid 17th c and put down roots at Kilconnor County Carlow. By the end of the century many members of the family had joined the Society of Friends and were part of the landed gentry. During the late 17th c and 18th c family members established themselves elsewhere in Ireland and later in Australia, England and New Zealand where they rose to prominence in a wide variety of roles, eventually abandoning Friends for the established church. Today the family is still held in high regard for its past and ongoing contributions to equestrian sports including horse racing, fox hunting, polo and in this era three day eventing. In Ireland Solomon Watson established a well known but doomed bank in Clonmel County Tipperary. John Henry Watson of Ballydarton County Carlow, master of the Carlow and Island hunt, started the Watsons association with hunting in which they became preeminent from the end of the 18th c. After serving in India, a later John Henry Watson helped develop the game of polo and his Freebooters team won the first international polo match against the Americans. Corona Deane Lecky Watson is remembered with great affection for her exquisite cultivated gardens at Altamont County Carlow which she bequeathed to the Republic of Ireland. In recent times John Wilfred Watson represented Ireland in the Olympics, won silver in the world eventing championship and team gold in the Europeans. His son Samuel James Watson won a team silver in the same event in 2018. In England John Boles Watson established theatres in the South West, the Midlands and Wales including the Theatre Royal in Cheltenham and in the 20th c John Arthur Fergus Watson became a reforming magistrate, prison visitor, campaigner on juvenile justice, author and president of the Royal Society of Chartered Surveyors. Alister George Douglas Watson was secretary of The Cambridge Apostles and friend of Keynes and Wittgenstein. During WWII he helped design millimetre radar and later became head of anti submarine warfare research. Peter Wright, the author of *Spycatcher*, accused him of being the fifth man, although later evidence showed otherwise. In Australia George John Watson, the prince of starters, developed the hunt in Victoria, ran a coaching business, bred horses, raced and helped found the Victorian Racing Club. His children were well known sportsmen, adventurers and pioneers in Queensland and the Northern Territory. His cousin William Currie Watson, a popular sportsman, was a pioneer in Gippsland, Victoria, where he cleared 300 ft trees and dense scrub to create a dairy farm and help establish a thriving dairy industry. John Watson, another relative, shipped to New Zealand in 1843 where he was appointed magistrate for the wild frontier district of Akaroa on the South Island. Again from the 19th c onwards many family members served with distinction in the military in India, South Africa, Europe and the middle east. The stories related in this book derive from meticulous research conducted by the authors who have utilised information provided by Watson descendants and from collections of diaries, photographs, letters and other

documents The book is printed in colour with 578 pages of well referenced text 262 illustrations 30 tables and a comprehensive index It includes genealogical charts for the various families a colour code for each branch and an ID number for each individual

Hatton, 1993-05-28 The Largest Amount of Good is the first full account of Quaker relief operations in Ireland and of the evolution of the Quakers thinking on the purposes and limitations of philanthropy and the responsibility of the state in disaster Helen Hatton describes how the Quakers rejected orthodox economic and philanthropic theory and without seeking profit for themselves provided grants and unguaranteed loans to develop and revitalize Irish agriculture fisheries and industry They also used publicity and political pressure to push for reform of the land holding system Although the power of the landowners was too entrenched to be overcome entirely the Quakers' contribution to Ireland Hatton demonstrates is unquestionable The growth of the Quaker relief service from mutual help in the seventeenth century to an institution of international standing has been accompanied by the gradual embodiment of their principles in the direction of the Society

Charitable Words Margaret Preston, 2004-10-30 Mismanaged by local authority in the 19th century Dublin lacked sufficient industrial development to provide adequate employment Dublin's charitable workers attempted to improve the lives of the thousands who flocked to the city in search of relief As a means to examining the hidden incentives of charity the author offers a discussion of the language of charity in this setting She notes how contemporary notions of race class and religion influenced how Ireland's philanthropists thought of and related to the poor While much has been written on the perceived racial inferiority of the Celt as compared to the Anglo Saxon Preston suggests that the Irish upper classes in seeking to gain equal footing with the British elite adopted the same language to describe the poor Intense sectarian strife marred Irish charities and undermined the smooth operation of social services Preston offers insight by focusing on two women philanthropists who battled for the souls of Ireland's children She also explores those who remained above the fray such as the Religious Society of Friends in Ireland who offered aid to all regardless of creed Within the charitable records of this group Preston contends that one can see how the Society changed over time and that in Ireland the industrial revolution as well as the 1798 Rebellion contributed to the Society adapting to the mainstream Finally the women of charity helped to establish a modern nursing system for Ireland and this work details their efforts at turning nursing into a respectable profession for women
