Ethical and Philosophical Consideration of the Dual-Use Dilemma in the Biological Sciences Seumas Miller, Michael J. Selgelid, 2008-07-30 What Is the Dual Use Dilemma The so called dual use dilemma arises in the context of research in the biological and other sciences as a consequence of the fact that one and the same piece of scientific research sometimes has the potential to be used for harm as well as for good A dual use dilemma is an ethical dilemma and an ethical dilemma for the researcher and for those who have the power or authority to assist or impede the researcher's work e.g. governments It is an ethical dilemma since it is about promoting good in the context of the potential for also causing harm e.g. the promotion of health in the context of providing the wherewithal for

the killing of innocents. It is an ethical dilemma for the researcher not because he or she is aiming at anything other than a good outcome; typically the researcher intends no harm but only good. Rather the dilemma arises for the researcher because of the potential actions of others. Malevolent non-researchers might steal dangerous biological agents produced by the researcher; alternatively other researchers or at least their governments or leadership might use the results of the original researcher's work for malevolent purposes. The malevolent purposes in question include bioterrorism, biowarfare and blackmail for financial gain.

The destructive application of biotechnology research includes activities such as spreading common pathogens or transforming them into even more lethal forms. Policymakers and the scientific community at large must put forth a vigorous and immediate response to this challenge. This new book by the National Research Council recommends that the government expand existing regulations and rely on self-governance by scientists rather than adopt intrusive new policies. One key recommendation of the report is that the government should not attempt to regulate scientific publishing but should trust scientists and journals to screen their papers for security risks, a task some journals have already taken up. With biological information and tools widely distributed

regulating only U S researchers would have little effect A new International Forum on Biosecurity should encourage the adoption of similar measures around the world Seven types of risky studies would require approval by the Institutional Biosafety Committees that already oversee recombinant DNA research at some 400 U S institutions These experiments of concern include making an infectious agent more lethal and rendering vaccines powerless

Innovation, Dual Use, and Security Jonathan B.
