Chapter 1: Biology: Exploring Life

- Levels of biological organization from smallest to largest: molecules \rightarrow organisms \rightarrow cells \rightarrow tissues \rightarrow organs \rightarrow organ systems \rightarrow organisms (populations, communities, ecosystems, biomes)
- New properties emerge at each level of organization. The properties of life emerge at the cellular level, as do life's structure, organization, and function.
- The basis of life's unity and diversity is the genetic information in DNA molecules.
- Kingdoms organize life into five domains: (1) Bacteria and (2) Eukarya are single-celled prokaryotic organisms; (3) Eukarya include plants, fungi, fungi, and animals. Plants are primarily single-celled eukaryotes. Plants, fungi, and animals are mostly multicellular organisms that differ in how they obtain nutrients.
- Domains theory of evolution based on natural selection is the core theme of biology.
- Hypothesis based evidence follows two basic steps:

**Chapter 2: The Chemical Basis of Life**

- Matter consists of elements. Elements are combined to form compounds.
- Molecules (two elements are combined for life) Oxygen, carbon, hydrogen, and nitrogen are the most abundant.
- Atoms are the smallest units of matter that retain the properties of an element. Atoms consist of protons (+), electrons (-), and neutrons (neutral). Different isotopes of an element have varying numbers of neutrons.
- Chemical interactions determine the chemical properties of an atom. Atoms with incomplete electron shells gain, lose, or share electrons, forming chemical bonds with other atoms.
- Ionic bonds are attractions between oppositely charged ions.
- Molecules in solution form hydrogen bonds when they are sharing electrons.
- Water is a polar molecule, neutral electron sharing bonds have slightly negative (-) and and more slightly positive (+) ends.



- Most attractions between slightly charged (+) and negatively charged groups of molecules are called hydrogen bonds. Water's polarity and hydrogen

bonding explain most of its life-supporting properties.

- Acids solutions have more H⁺ ions than OH⁻ ions and alkali less than 7. Basic solutions have fewer H⁺ ions than OH⁻ ions and a pH greater than 7.
- Chemical reactions change the composition of matter as reactants are converted to products.

Chapter 3: The Molecules of Cells

- Carbon is at the center of life's diversity. Organic compounds vary in (1) the size and shape of the carbon skeletons and (2) the primary and location of functional groups.
- Cells make a huge number of polymers from a small set of monomers, linked by dehydration reactions.
- Carbohydrates. Monomers (sugars) provide cells with energy and molecular building blocks. Polysaccharides store energy in animals (glycogen) and in plants (starch) and provide structure in plant cell walls (cellulose).
- Lipids are hydrophobic. They include fat (energy storage), phospholipids (cell membrane components), and steroids (such as cholesterol and sex hormones). Most animal fats are saturated. Plant oils are mostly unsaturated (have one hydrogen less per double bond in the carbon skeleton).
- Proteins are important structural elements of cells and participate in most cellular activities. Twenty different amino acids are the monomeric precursors. The carboxyl end of one amino acid is linked to a peptide bond with the amino group of the next to form a polypeptide.
- A protein consists of one or more polypeptide folds, and some specific shape that determines the protein's function. Four levels may contribute to this shape: (1) the amino acid sequence (primary structure); (2) coiling or pleating held by hydrogen bonds (secondary structure); (3) the overall shape held by noncovalent forces (tertiary structure); and (4) association of more than one polypeptide (quaternary structure).
- Nucleic acids are polymers of nucleotides. DNA, the molecule of inheritance, is a double helix; two polynucleotide strands held together by hydrogen bonds between bases. DNA is transcribed into RNA, a single-stranded nucleic acid, which is then translated into the primary structure of proteins.

Chapter 4: A Tour of the Cell

- Prokaryotic cells are small and structurally simple.

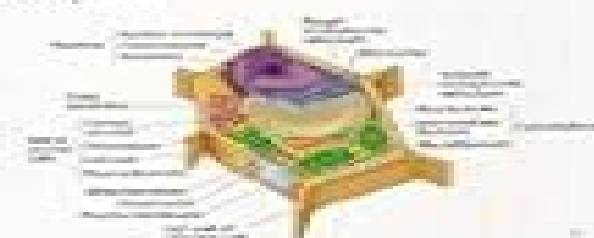


- Eukaryotic cells are larger and more complex, with a nucleus and membrane-bounded organelles that perform specific functions.

- An animal cell.



- A plant cell.



- The plasma membrane and the endomembrane system perform diverse functions that depend on the membrane structure. Phospholipids are the membrane's main component.
- Within the nucleus, DNA and proteins make up chromatin fibers. Each fiber is a chromosome.
- The endoplasmic reticulum (ER) consists of a network of membranes, through ER makes carbohydrates and secretory proteins. A small ER compartment (cisterna) and acts in detoxification.
- Ribosomes are the rough ER and nuclear envelope, and in the cytoplasm, make proteins.
- The Golgi apparatus refines ER products and packages them in transport vesicles.
- Lysosomes are membrane-bounded organelles that function in digestion within the cell and chemical recycling.
- Plant cells have cell walls, a large central vacuole, chloroplasts (which convert solar energy to chemical energy), and plasmodesmata (channels between adjacent cells).
- Mitochondria, double-membraned organelles, are the sites of cellular respiration, converting food energy to ATP. Mitochondria, like chloroplasts, evolved by endosymbiosis.
- Microtubules, intermediate filaments, and motor proteins are proteins fibers that confer on the cytoskeleton, the cell's internal framework.
- Cells and organelles are further appraised by such processes as osmosmosis.
- Junctions between animal cells help hold them together or, and some provide communication between cells.

Chapter 5: The Working Cell

- A membrane is a fluid mosaic of proteins floating in a phospholipid bilayer. The proteins serve as transport agents, enzymes, active, signal receptors, signal transducers, formation of cell junctions, and transport.
