them specially drawn for this history and photographs often taken by Morison himself as he flew at low altitude along the coastal routes of explorers which together identify virtually every allusion to land and sea made by the great European navigators in their ship logs and their later accounts With the 500th anniversary of the European arrival in America came much controversy over Columbus's true legacy With its lively and engaging style and with its unsurpassed understanding of the age The European Discovery of America helps put the era of exploration in much needed perspective Anyone interested in the history of America indeed in the history of Western Civilization will find these volumes absolutely essential
