Arte Povera:

Arte Povera Simon Baier, Sammlung Goetz, 2012 The term Arte Povera was introduced by the influential critic and curator Germano Celant in 1967 to describe a new art that expressed the economic and cultural turbulence of the late 1960s in Italy This art became identified with the use of poor materials such as soil glass wood and wax but in fact its products ranged from paintings and sculptures to photographs and performances Artists such as Giovanni Anselmo Alighiero Boetti Jannis Kounellis Mario Merz Pino Pascali and Michelangelo Pistoletti were the stars of this new movement and their innovations have made for a lasting legacy among subsequent generations exploring raw materials the possibilities of the gallery space and everyday detritus The Sammlung Goetz possesses one of the most comprehensive collections of Arte Povera presented in this publication for the first time alongside archival photographs and documents *Arte Povera* Carolyn Christov-Bakargiev, 1999-02-25 In 1967 the critic Germano Celant defined as Arte Povera poor art the work of 13 world renowned young Italian artists This work documents and explains the sculpture and installation work of these artists in the context of the critics who shaped it and the broader cultural framework of contemporaneous philosophers film makers and curators The innovative works of the artists were lyrical open ended combinations of unlikely fragments like horses wandering through a gallery a slab of marble with a lettuce using the most banal materials a metaphysical dimension The artists included Anselmo Boetti Calzolari Fabro Kounellis Mario and Marisa Merz Paolini Pascali Penone Pistoletti Prini and Zorio many of whom have emerged as world class artists who continue to exhibit internationally Their work and statements are published alongside contemporaneous texts by critics and other thinkers of their day Arte Povera Robert Lumley, 2004 The term Arte Povera was coined in 1967 by the critic Germano Celant to describe a group of Italian artists making work that used the simplest means to create poetic statements based on events of everyday life Seen as a reaction against the commercialism of the art market and the dominance of American Minimalist and Pop art the work demonstrated a keen hunger to explore new materials In this fully illustrated survey Robert Lumley provides a concise and highly readable interpretation of Arte Povera informed by extensive interviews with the artists themselves **Arte povera** Germano Celant, 1985 Arte Povera Seen by Ingvild Goetz Douglas Fogle, Chiara Vecchiarelli, 2018 An extensive chronology provides an in depth view of Goetz's history with the Arte Povera movement as a gallerist in the 1970s and 1980s and subsequently as a collector Read alongside a conversation with Goetz herself the publication profiles the collector's personal relationship with the Italian art movement and its artists detailing the evolution of her own extensive collection The book includes previously unpublished archival materials that trace the evolution of Goetz's collection as well as newly commissioned essays from curators Douglas Fogle and Chiara Vecchiarelli Fogle explores the connection of Arte Povera and American post minimalist movements more widely of the 1960s and 1970s Vecchiarelli for her part examines the history of the galleries and dealers who first presented Arte Povera and their influence on the evolution of the movement Artists included Claudio Abate Giovanni Anselmo Alighiero

Born in the midst of the delicate political situation in Italy in the 1960s Arte Povera introduced by the Italian art critic and curator Germano Celant was a reaction to Pop and Minimalism reflecting the anti establishment mood of the period with its rejection of a consumer society based on profit *Arte Povera* Claire Gilman, 2001 This catalogue shows important Arte Povera works from the Sonnabend Collection that have rarely been exhibited in New York Each of the Arte Povera artists in the Sonnabend Collectio is represented The essay of Claire Gilman reexamines the Italian movement that Ileana Sonnabend was instrumental in bringing to the world s attention Ileana Sonnabend s pioneering efforts in the promotion and dissemination art have long been celebrated Less known is Sonnabend s early and unceasing dedication to European art of the sixties and senventies particularly to the art of Italy Late in 1962 Michael and Ileana Sonnabend opened the Galerie Ileana Sonnabend in Paris where they exhibited the work of American artists but also the work of several young Italians beginning with Mario Schifano 1963 and Michelangelo Pistoletto 1964 In addition to Pistoletto Ileana Sonnabend showed the work of Giovanni Anselmo Pier Paolo Calzolari Jannis Kounellis Mario Merz Giulio Paolini and Gilberto Zorio both in Paris and in the New York gallery that she had opened in 1970 In this way Sonnabend played a seminal role not only in introducing American art to Europe but also in bringing contemporary European art to America The Arte Povera was a group of twelve artists Giovanni Anselmo Alighiero Boetti Pier Paolo Calzolari Luciano Fabro Jannis Kounellis Mario Merz Marisa Merz Giulio Paolini Pino Pascali Guiseppe Penone Michelangelo Pistoletto Gilberto Zorio They produced one of the most authentic and independent European artistic interventions of the late 1960s Pitted in certain ways against the hegemony of American art specifically that of minimalist sculpture it was also an artistic movement that recuperated the contradictory legacy of Italian avant garde culture from the beginning of the century as defined in the dialectics of Futurism and Giorgio De Chirico s Pittura Metafisica **Che Fare?** Kunstmuseum Liechtenstein, 2010 The artists of the Arte Povera movement sought to bridge the gap between art and life expanding consciousness by reducing the distance between the artwork and the spectator The familiar ordinary things often regarded as worthless were to be rediscovered as new art worthy materials previously neglected everyday items were to be transformed into meaningful works of art The new art was to be more simple and more modest in its means and more authentic in its materials This influential groundbreaking movement is explored in images and text in this comprehensive catalogue **Arte Povera** Robert Lumley, 2004-10 Arte Povera poor art came of age in the context of the economic boom of the Italian miracle and the subsequent student and workers revolts of 1968 Its work was motivated by an urge to revolt against not only the primacy achieved by painting in the postwar period but also against certain aspects of the emerging consumer culture Published to accompany an exhibition organized in a collaboration between the Walker Art Center Minneapolis and the Tate Modern this book provides a retrospective of the Arte Povera
