The Artful Universe Expanded John Barrow, 2011-03-10 In *The Artful Universe* OUP 1995 John D Barrow explored the close ties between our aesthetic appreciation and the basic nature of the Universe challenging the commonly held view that our sense of beauty is entirely free and unfettered It looked at some of the unexpected ways in which the structure of the Universe its laws its environments and above all its underlying mathematical structure imprints itself on our thoughts our aesthetic preferences and our views about the nature of things The exploration embraced topics such as perspective the size of things and the origins of aesthetics computer art posing the question is it art and the origins of our susceptibility to music Life sales of the hardback totalled just over 25 000 copies The study of the evolutionary and mathematical underpinnings of our aesthetic sense and our understanding of the nature and scale of the universe has grown over the past decade with developments in evolutionary psychology and in cosmology This paperback of the revised edition OUP 2005 contains eight new sections covering the recent discoveries of extrasolar planets fashionable postmodernist rejection of science as uncovering objective reality growing understanding of key ratios appearing in biological relationships and studies of the underlying mathematical structure of a Pollock painting *The Artful Universe* John D. Barrow, 2008 Cosmology the universe *Time in Eternity* Robert John Russell, 2012-06-15 According to Robert John Russell one of the foremost scholars on relating Christian theology and science the topic of time and eternity is central to the relation between God and the world in two ways First it involves the notion of the divine eternity as the supratemporal source of creaturely time Second it involves the eternity of the eschatological New Creation beginning with the bodily Resurrection of Jesus in relation to creaturely time The key to Russell's engagement with these issues and the purpose of this book is to explore Wolfhart Pannenberg's treatment of time and eternity in relation to mathematics physics and cosmology *Time in Eternity* is the first book length exposition of Russell's unique method for relating Christian theology and the natural sciences which he calls creative mutual interaction CMI This method first calls for

a reformulation of theology in light of science and then for the delineation of possible topics for research in science drawing on this reformulated theology Accordingly Russell first reformulates Pannenberg's discussion of the divine attributes eternity and omnipresence in light of the way time and space are treated in mathematics physics and cosmology This leads him to construct a correlation of eternity and omnipresence in light of the spacetime framework of Einstein's special relativity In the process he proposes a new flowing time interpretation of relativity to counter the usual block universe interpretation supported by most physicists and philosophers of science Russell also replaces Pannenberg's use of Hegel's concept of infinity in relation to the divine attributes with the concept of infinity drawn from the mathematics of Georg Cantor Russell then addresses the enormous challenge raised by Big Bang cosmology to Christian eschatology In response he draws on Pannenberg's interpretation both of the Resurrection as a proleptic manifestation of the eschatological New Creation within history and the present as the arrival of the future Russell shows how such a reformulated understanding of theology can shed light on possible directions for fundamental research in physics and cosmology These lead him to explore preconditions in contemporary physics research for the possibility of duration copresence retroactive causality and prolepsis in nature

Aschenbrenner,2012-12-06 This inquiry may be thought of as a sequel to The Concepts of Value and as an extension of the brief core vocabulary of aesthetic concepts found in one of the appendices to it In terms of sheer numbers most of the value concepts of our language are to be found in the area of human relations and of the aesthetic There are also other value vocabularies shorter but equally important for example the cognitive and logical These and other objects of philosophical study for example the question of other minds deserve the kind of empirical survey that has been made of moral and aesthetic notions if only to test a priori approaches to them In the present study an even more determined empirical approach than that adopted for the first has been found necessary Once the moral or human value vocabulary has been identified sentential contexts for the use of the terms readily come to mind In a study of the language of criticism however the vocabulary has first to be sought in the utterances of critics themselves and quoted in sufficient context to make their critical intentions clear The outcome is that the present study is of great length about half of it being quotations from critics The rule adopted for arriving at this length go on collecting quotations as long as new types of appraisal came was to to light *Arts*
