ideal compost area is a dry shady spot near a water source with dimensions of 3 x 3 x 3 feet



Add the ingredients

The ingredients are those rich in carbon (brown materials) and those rich in nitrogen (green materials) Make sure large materials are chapped or shredded



Add water as needed

Make sure the pile stays moist, but not too wet (It should feel like a damp sponge)



Wait a while

When the compost no langer gives off heat and becomes dry, brown and crumbly, it's fully cooked and ready to be fed to the garden.

Keep things moving

Turn your compost medure to add air to the mix. This helps speed up the composting process
