Nnolim, 2010 This Third Edition of *Approaches to the African Novel* is a child of necessity Because of the unfortunate death of the publisher of Saros International who issued the First Edition and high demand this third enlarged edition has become imperative Three new essays all previously published are added two expectedly on Achebe the father of the African novel and one on Mongp Beti's Mission to Kala which was partially anthologised in *Contemporary Literary Criticism* Volume 27 1984 Achebe's *Things Fall Apart* as an Igbo national epic has evoked a spate of reactions from critics of African literature especially the troika Chinweizu et al in *Toward the Decolonization of African Literature* It was also anthologised in *Modern Black Literature* edited by S Okechukwu Menu 1971 The essay on Arrow of God whose structure and meaning has been largely avoided by other critics is included here for further airing For gender balance as the previous volume contained no essays on women writers an essay on Flora Nwapa has been added Since the novels discussed in this volume exclusively are on the African literature south of the Sahara the last essay on Peter Abrahams comes in to round out this collection of essays with a study of a south African writer for geographical balance

**A History of Twentieth-century African Literatures** Oyekan Owomoyela, 1993-01-01 African literatures says volume editor Oyekan Owomoyela testify to the great and continuing impact of the colonizing project on the African universe African writers must struggle constantly to define for themselves and other just what Africa is and who they are in a continent constructed as a geographic and cultural entity largely by Europeans This study reflects the legacy of colonialism by devoting nine of its thirteen chapters to literature in Europhone languages English French and Portuguese Foremost among the Anglophone writers discussed are Nigerians Amos Tutuola Chinua Achebe and Wole Soyinka Writers from East Africa are also represented as are those from South Africa Contributors for this section include Jonathan A Peters Arlene A Elder John F Povey Thomas Knipp and J Ndukaku Amankulor In African Francophone literature we see both writers inspired by the French assimilationist system and those influenced by Negritude the African culture affirmation movement Contributors here include Servanne Woodward Edris Makward and Alain Ricard African literature in Portuguese reflecting the nature of one of the most oppressive colonizing projects in Africa is treated by Russell G Hamilton Robert Cancel discusses African language literatures while Oyekan Owomoyela treats the question of the language of African literatures Carole Boyce Davies and Elaine Savory Fido focus on the special problems of African women writers while Hans M Zell deals with the broader issues of publishing censorship resources and organization

Postcolonial Imaginations and Moral Representations in African Literature and Culture Chielozona Eze, 2011-12-16 The postcolonial African culture as it is discoursed in the academia is largely influenced by Africa's response to colonialism To the degree that it is a response it is to considerably reactive and

lacks forceful moral incentives for social critical consciousness and nation building Quite on the contrary it allows especially African political leaders to luxuriate in the delusions of moral rectitude imploring at will the evil of imperialism as a buffer to their disregard of their people This book acknowledges the social and psychological devastations of colonialism on the African world It however argues that the totality of African intellectual response to colonialism and Western imperialism is equally if not more damaging to the African world In what ways does the average African leader indeed the average African judge and respond to his world How does he conceive of his responsibility towards his community and society The most obvious impact of African response to colonialism is the implicit search for a pristine innocent paradigm in for instance literary philosophical social political and gender studies This search has its own moral implication in the sense that it makes the taking of responsibility on individual and social level highly difficult Focusing on the moral impact of responses to colonialism in Africa and the African Diaspora this book analyzes the various manifestations of delusions of moral innocence that has held the African leadership from the onerous task of bearing responsibility for their countries it argues that one of the ways to recast the African leaders responsibility towards Africa is to let go on the one hand the gaze of the West and on the other of the search for the innocent African experience and cultures Relying on the insights of thinkers such as Frantz Fanon Wole Soyinka Kwame Anthony Appiah Achille Mbembe and Wolfgang Iser this book suggests new approaches to interpreting African experiences It discusses select African works of fiction as a paradigm for new interpretations of African experiences

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
