American Women Conservationists Madelyn Holmes, 2004-04-20. This collection of biographies describes twelve women conservationists who helped change the ways Americans interact with the natural environment. Their writings led Americans to think differently about their land: deserts are not wastelands, swamps have value, and harmful insects don't have to be controlled chemically.

These women not only wrote on behalf of conservation of the American landscape but also described strategies for living exemplary environmentally sound lives during the past century. A conclusion examines where conservationists have picked up after Rachel Carson's *Silent Spring* (1962) and gives conservation ideas for our time. An appendix lists the published writings of the twelve conservationists.
