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Mathematical Software - ICMS 2010 Komei Fukuda, Joris van der Hoeven, Michael Joswig, Nobuki Takayama, 2010-08-30 The ICMS Developer's Meeting is an international congress for which the main theme is mathematical software. The 2010 meeting was the third of a series of meetings of similar theme, the first being held in Beijing, China in 2002 and the second in Castro Urdiales, Spain in 2006. The field of mathematics has numerous branches and in each branch we find that algorithms and also implementations and applications of software systems are studied. Researchers who endeavor to make such studies also have international meetings within their specific branches of mathematics and these meetings have made significant contributions to the fields in which they lie. The ICMS International Congress on Mathematical Software on the other hand is a general, not branch specific meeting on mathematical software which is held every four years and is a rare opportunity for developers of mathematical software from different branches of mathematics as well as mathematicians who are interested in mathematical software to gather together.

The articles are arranged in roughly alphabetical order and cover a wide spectrum of modern group theory. Proceedings of earlier Groups St Andrews conferences have had a major impact on the development of group theory and these volumes should be equally important.

On the other hand, more than one third of the papers deal with computations in matrix groups giving an in-depth treatment of the currently most active area of the field. The points of view of the papers range from explicit computations to group theoretic algorithms to group theoretic theorems needed for algorithm development.

O'Brien, 2025-05-05 This book provides a comprehensive coverage of the theory of conjugacy in finite classical groups. Given such a classical group G , the three fundamental problems considered are the following: to list a representative for each conjugacy class of G ; to describe the centralizer of each representative by giving its group structure and a generating set; and to solve the conjugacy problem in G , namely given two elements of G establish whether they are conjugate and if so find a conjugating element. The book presents comprehensive theoretical solutions to all three problems and uses these solutions to formulate practical algorithms. In parallel to the theoretical work, implementations of these algorithms have been developed.
