Block Beuys, photographs Manfred Leve, Joseph Beuys, 2004 Joseph Beuys created his Block Beuys installation in the 1960s out of greatly varied materials and salvaged items that were selected manipulated altered and brought together in unusual ways The objects correspond to one another and in their unmistakable forms refer to the artist's work in its entirety Block Beuys is installed in a series of seven interconnected rooms in the Hessisches Landesmuseum in Darmstadt In Leve's view Beuys the photographer Manfred Leve has documented Block Beuys not only in the variety of its individual pieces but also with a view of the entire work of art His black and white photos devoid of any kind of staging allow a thorough and genuine look at this radiant work
