I tried to call for help, but no sound came from my mouth. I tried to run away, but I could not move my legs. I have never felt so frightened before. I finally managed to scream in terror, and in doing so I woke myself up. It was a great relief to return to reality.

The first two sentences of the third paragraph begin with the same words and have similar structure. This repetition adds drama to the situation

My mother came to my room to make sure that I was all right. 'I'm fine,' I said. 'It was just a bad dream.'

Ending a story with direct speech can sometimes be effective.
