Allegory and Representation Stephen Jay Greenblatt, 1981 **Reading Contexts** Neil Forsyth, 1988 **The Persistence of Allegory** Jane K. Brown, 2013-04-23 In an impressively comparative work Jane K Brown explores the tension in European drama between allegory and neoclassicism from the sixteenth through the nineteenth century Imitation of nature is generally thought to triumph over religious allegory in the Elizabethan and French classical theater a shift attributable to the recovery of Aristotle's Poetics in the Renaissance But if Aristotle's terminology was rapidly assimilated Brown demonstrates that change in dramatic practice took place only gradually and partially and that allegory was never fully cast off the stage The book traces a complex history of neoclassicism in which new allegorical forms flourish and older ones are constantly revitalized Brown reveals the allegorical survivals in the works of such major figures as Shakespeare Calderon Racine Vondel Metastasio Goethe and Wagner and reads tragedy comedy masque opera and school drama together rather than as separate developments Throughout she draws illuminating parallels to modes of representation in the visual arts A work of broad interest to scholars teachers and students of theatrical form The Persistence of Allegory presents a fundamental rethinking of the history of European drama **Structures of Appearing: Allegory and the Work of Literature** Brenda Machosky, 2013 Structures of Appearing Allegory and the Work of Literature is an interdisciplinary study that revises the history of allegory through a phenomenological approach The book also takes on the history of aesthetics as an ideology that has long subjugated literature and art generally to criteria of judgment that are philosophical rather than literary **Allegories of Dissent** Sharon G. Kamath, 2012 An examination of medieval vernacular allegories across a number of languages offers a new idea of what authorship meant in the late middle ages The emergence of vernacular allegories in the middle ages recounted by a first person narrator protagonist invites both abstract and specific interpretations of the author s role since the protagonist who claims to compose the narrative also directs the reader to interpret such claims Moreover the specific attributes of the narrator protagonist bring greater attention to individual identity But as the actual authors of the allegories also adapted elements found in each other s works their shared literary tradition unites differing perspectives the most celebrated French first person allegory the erotic *Roman de la Rose* quickly inspired an allegorical trilogy of spiritual pilgrimage narratives by Guillaume de Deguileville English authors sought recognition for their own literary activity through adaptation and translation from a tradition inspired by both allegories This account examines Deguileville s underexplored allegory before tracing the tradition s importance to the English authors Geoffrey Chaucer Thomas Hoccleve and John Lydgate with particular attention to the mediating influence of French authors including Christine de Pizan and Laurent de Premierfait Through comparative analysis of the late medieval authors who shaped French and English literary canons it reveals the seminal communal model of vernacular authorship established by the tradition of first person allegory Stephanie A.
