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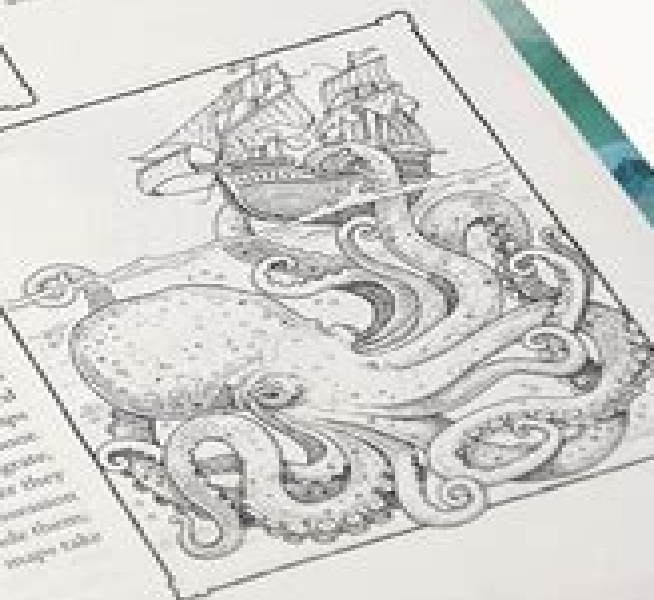

Klondike
 is doing the work of a large, flat blanket in which except where, in places of water, is laid a piece of flannel. Kraken
The oldest of the sea creatures, krakens have been traced back as far as the Cretaceous period, co-existing with the Tyrannosaurus rex. Their tentacles range in number from eight to forty-six, depending on the species. They are terrifying in their movements of hunger; there have been accounts of krakens consuming as many as five hundred sailors in a single day, and the whirlpools created by their tentacles can pull ships of enormous size to the sea-floor. Krakens do not in general migrate, and remain in the body of water they were born in, so sailors in possession of good maps can usually evade them, but those who sail without maps take their lives in their hands.
