Arms And The Man And John Bulls Other Island:

Man and Superman, John Bull's Other Island, and Major Barbara George Bernard Shaw, 2021 Nobel Laureate George Bernard Shaw remains one of the world's most important and popular writers. His plays are regularly performed around the world from the boards of Broadway and the West End to regional community and college stages. The three plays selected here are widely considered to be three of the most important in the canon of modern British theatre. *Man and Superman* a four act comedy for serious people staged in part at Royal Court in 1905 it is one of the early works of Modernism to take an ancient myth and restage it in contemporary mode and its influence extends across world literature palpable in writings from Mann to Joyce. Its story of how a sensitive woman compels a superman figure to adjust to her needs and those of the real world provides an updated commentary on Nietzsche's still fashionable notions of *ubermensch* and its famous third act introduces a persistent Shavian theme which goes back as far as earliest religious literature that the truly damned are those who are happy in hell. *John Bull's Other Island* takes up that idea to the visionary hell may be the ultimate modern dream of efficiency and rational administration as manifested in a colonial Ireland run by liberal exploiters. Commissioned by WB Yeats to mark the opening of Ireland's National Theatre the Abbey the play was promptly refused by its Directors who disliked its mechanical mockeries of mechanism but may have missed its visionary qualities. It was performed to huge acclaim in London in November 1904 and it made Shaw famous the supreme example of the Playwright as Thinker and ever afterwards one of the most valued commentators on Anglo Irish relations. *Major Barbara* a three act drama which in classic Shavian style unmasks the motivation of puritan idealists and dedicated industrialists this work like the previous two pits a strong woman against a sardonic practical man. Having exposed the mendacity of apostles of efficiency Shaw seems then to submit to their doctrine arguing that a pure private charity towards the destitute is no adequate substitute. Like the previous two works this is a problem play in the course of which the audience sympathy is aroused and then repelled in all directions. The suggestion that it may be acceptable to take money from tainted sources such as arms manufacturers caused much debate in 1905 and even more after the carnage wrought by mechanized guns in World War One.

John Bull's Other Island Bernard Shaw, 2016-07-29 George Bernard Shaw was an Irish playwright and critic who was very influential in Western theatre in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Shaw who won the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1925 was a prolific writer and considered by many to be one of the greatest dramatists in history. Shaw's most famous works include *Pygmalion*, *Arms and the Man*, *Man and Superman* and *Saint Joan*. *John Bull's Other Island* is a satirical comedy set in Dublin. The action centers around Larry Doyle an Irishman who with a partner named Tom Broadbent runs a business in England. The two men go to Ireland to develop land.

1992, Shaw and the Last Hundred Years Bernard Frank Dukore, 1994 In 1892 the first production of Bernard Shaw's first play *Widowers Houses* heralded the birth of modern drama in the English language. One hundred years later a group of Shavians gathered to examine the significance and influence of Shaw's drama in the English speaking world.

Sidney and Beatrice Webb were among the outstanding political personalities in the period 1890-1945. They were leading figures in the Fabian Society, prominent historians and founders of the London School of Economics and the New Statesman. They exchanged letters with many of the leading figures in the political, intellectual and literary worlds of the time, among them Herbert Asquith, Ramsay MacDonald, George Bernard Shaw and Bertrand Russell. Volume II of the letters covers the years between the Webb marriage and their return from Asia in 1912. They were the prime years of the partnership in which the Webbs came to dominate the Fabian Society, founded the London School of Economics and launched their campaign for the reform of the Poor Law. *Bernard Shaw, Sean O'Casey, and the Dead James Connolly* Nelson O'Ceallaigh

Ritschel, 2021-07-21. This book details the Irish socialistic tracks pursued by Bernard Shaw and Sean O'Casey, mostly after 1916, that were arguably impacted by the executed James Connolly. The historical context is carefully unearthed, stretching from its 1894 roots via W.B. Yeats' dream of Shaw as a menacing yet grinning sewing machine to Shaw's and O'Casey's 1928 masterworks. In the process, Shaw's *War Issues for Irishmen*, *Annajanska the Bolshevik Empress*, *The Tragedy of an Elderly Gentleman*, *Saint Joan*, *The Intelligent Woman's Guide to Socialism and Capitalism* and O'Casey's *The Story of the Irish Citizen Army*, *The Shadow of a Gunman*, *Juno and the Paycock*, *The Plough and the Stars* and *The Silver Tassie* are reconsidered, revealing previously undiscovered textures to the masterworks. All of which provides a rethinking and a reconsideration of Ireland's great drama of the 1920s as well as furthering the knowledge of Shaw, O'Casey and Connolly.

From Manila to the Monkey Trial Gary Shuster, 2006-03. An easy-to-read episodic history of America from 1900 through 1925. Besides politics, the book also includes scandals, fashion, literature, sports, music, domestic issues, etc. 296 pages with illustrations. *Shaw and History* Gale K. Larson, 1999. This special issue of *Shaw* offers ten articles that focus on the theme of Shaw and History. That focus illuminates Shaw's concept of history as art and its uses for dramatic purposes. It is a focus that is broadly applied to the historical perspective. Views range from Shaw's uses of historical sources in the Shavianizing of history, his uses of historical geographical and political places and events in his work, to views that place selected Shavian works within a historical context. Stanley Weintraub discusses Shaw's references to Cetewayo, Zulu chieftain in *Cashel Byron's Profession* as the first incorporation of a contemporary historical figure into his work. John Allett explores the liberal, socialist and radical feminist views of prostitution in nineteenth-century England and demonstrates how those political views are developed within the unfolding action of *Mrs Warren's Profession*. Sidney P. Albert studies the Utopian movement *The Garden City* to determine the extent to which that movement influenced Shaw's conception of *Perivale St. Andres* in *Major Barbara*. He also narrates his personal attempt to identify the Ballycorus smelting works and its surroundings as well as the campanile or Folly at Faringdon as sites that provided the scenic sources for *Perivale St. Andres* in *Major Barbara*. Gale K.

Larson has edited a partially unpublished Shavian manuscript that addresses Shaw's relationship with Frank Harris and among other matters sets the historical record right as to who deserves the credit for attributing the identity of the Dark Lady of the Sonnets to Mary Fitton. He also examines the historical sources that influenced Shaw's views on Charles II the Merry Monarch in *In Good King Charles's Golden Days* and demonstrates Shaw's reclamation of yet another historical figure from the traditional historians. David Gunby examines the first night performance of *O'Flaherty V.C.* for purposes of setting the historical record straight as to the facts of that production. Wendi Chen presents the stage history of the production of *Mrs Warren's Profession* in China during the early 1920s and argues its central role in shaping modern Chinese drama. Rodelle Weintraub assesses *Too True to Be Good* as a dream play within the context of the nightmarish times of World War I. Michael M. O'Hara surveys the Federal Theatre's productions of *Androcles and the Lion* in the 1930s to reveal the political and religious repressions that those productions underscore. Shaw 19 also includes three reviews of recent additions to Shavian scholarship as well as John R. Pfeiffer's *Continuing Checklist of Shaviana*. *Bernard Shaw, Playwright* Bernard F. Dukore, 2025-10-03 Bernard's Shaw's plays have delighted and stimulated audiences since their first appearances. Their author's satiric view of conventions, institutions, and behavior continues unfailingly to amuse while it provokes doubts about the honesty of the social and political attitudes that underlie them. Originally published in 1973, Dukore discusses the theory of drama that is the basis of Shaw's comedies, which present his views of mores and follies. That Shaw's theory was coherent and comprehensive, Dukore shows in Part One of this book with supportive references to Shaw's critical works, letters, speeches, and plays. In Part Two, using such familiar works as *Candida*, *Pygmalion*, and *Back to Methuselah*, as well as less known plays like *In Good King Charles's Golden Days* to reinforce his points, Dukore analyses the discussion play according to Shaw, the watershed of the new drama, *Androcles and the Lion*, and *Saint Joan*, along with other plays that illustrate Shaw's use of the prologue or prologue-like first act to create the play's social and psychological foundations. *Man and Superman* and *The Apple Cart* are among those which exemplify the play whose frame is both detachable from its centerpiece and also functionally integrated with it. Dukore also considers at length Shaw's reworking of other men's plays: Shakespeare's *Cymbeline* and Trebitsch's *Frau Gittas S'hne*, as well as his own *Major Barbara*. These revisions bring into sharp focus Shaw's perception of human nature and his principles of dramaturgy. Among others of Shaw's plays, Dukore presents *Too True to Be Good* and *Heartbreak House* as examples of his protoexistentialism, his apprehension of the absurd, and the existential forces in life. Throughout Shaw's plays, major and minor, Dukore sees the influence of the playwright's socialism and supports this observation with precise examples from the works.
