Engineers made this one of the most significant public works in the nation Each of the two systems provided cost effective and environmentally sound means to tap the rich mineral resources of the Kanawha Valley By any measure the Great Kanawha Navigation has been one of the more successful ventures of the Corps of Engineers Kemp has provided extensive photographs illustrations diagrams and maps to further emphasize the construction of the various hydraulic structures The result is an interesting and significant blend of biographical technical political geographical and industrial history that will delight historians of technology and the region
