Texas Art and a Wildcatter's Dream William E. Reaves, 1998 At a crucial moment in the development of Texas art an eccentric oil wildcatter from Massachusetts and Luling Texas turned to the prestigious San Antonio Art League with a proposal He would fund a national art competition featuring the state's verdant fields of wildflowers and bring prominence to Texas art if the league would handle the details Thus was born the Texas Wildflower Competitive Exhibitions which in three years at the end of the Roaring Twenties awarded more than 53 000 in prize money for paintings of Texas wildflowers ranch life and cotton farming This presentation of twenty nine color plates of the competitions best works includes paintings by such important artists as Jose Arpa Dawson Dawson Watson Xavier Gonzalez Edward G Eisenlohr and Oscar E Berninghaus and Herbert Dunton the latter duo having also served as founding members of the Taos Society of Artists In the plates the artists have portrayed a variety of landscapes and atmospheres to present the wildflowers loved not only by Davis but by generations of Texas art enthusiasts

Midcentury Modern Art in Texas Katie Robinson Edwards, 2014-07-01 Before Abstract Expressionism of New York City was canonized as American postwar modernism the United States was filled with localized manifestations of modern art One

such place where considerable modernist activity occurred was Texas where artists absorbed and interpreted the latest most radical formal lessons from Mexico the East Coast and Europe while still responding to the state s dramatic history and geography This barely known chapter in the story of American art is the focus of Midcentury Modern Art in Texas Presenting new research and artwork that has never before been published Katie Robinson Edwards examines the contributions of many modernist painters and sculptors in Texas with an emphasis on the era s most abstract and compelling artists Edwards looks first at the Dallas Nine and the 1936 Texas Centennial which offered local artists a chance to take stock of who they were and where they stood within the national artistic setting She then traces the modernist impulse through various manifestations including the foundations of early Texas modernism in Houston early practitioners of abstraction and non objectivity the Fort Worth Circle artists at the University of Texas at Austin Houston artists in the 1950s sculpture in and around an influential Fort Worth studio and to see how some Texas artists fared on a national scale the Museum of Modern Art s Americans exhibitions The first full length treatment of abstract art in Texas during this vital and canon defining period Midcentury Modern Art in Texas gives these artists their due place in American art while also valuing the quality of Texan ness that subtly undergirds much of their production

Sweetie Ladd's Historic Fort Worth Cissy Stewart Lale,Sweetie Ladd,1999 Sweetie Ladd was Fort Worth s own Grandma Moses a folk artist who captured the city s history in watercolor and lithograph In her sixties when she began painting Ladd once told a fellow artist she didn t know how she achieved her distinctive style Just paint poorly dear she advised In truth she had attended painting workshops in Paris Spain and Mexico and studied under Fort Worth artist Bror Utter After she took a class on perspective her teacher advised her to discontinue formal training and paint what came naturally Sweetie Ladd s Historic Fort Worth presents twenty eight paintings from the Landmark Series paintings of historic Fort Worth structures many of which no longer stand today the T Mrs Baird s Bread is the sign on a horse drawn carriage in The Breadman a Stripling s delivery cart is in front of the J E Moore home now part of the Woman s Club a horse drawn funeral procession passes in front of the old Washer Brothers building and Fuqua s Grocery sits next to Anderson Drugs in Extra Extra one of the Cries series in which a young boy passes out the Fort Worth Star Telegram Sweetie Ladd s paintings were shown at the Woman s Club of Fort Worth and accepted in juried shows of the University of Texas at Arlington the Fort Worth Art Museum and the Texas Fine Arts Association These historical paintings are now owned by the Fort Worth Public Library and have been reproduced with their cooperation Cissy Stewart Lale s text elucidates each painting explaining details and their historical significance The book begins with brief essays on Mrs Ladd and Fort Worth history

Rounded Up in Glory Michael Grauer, 2016-08-15 Frank Reaugh 1860 1945 pronounced Ray was called the Dean of Texas artists for good reason His pastels documented the wide open spaces of the West as they were vanishing in the late nineteenth century and his plein air techniques influenced generations of artists His students include a Who s Who of twentieth century Texas painters Alexandre Hogue Reveau Bassett and Lucretia Coke among others He was an advocate of painting by observation and encouraged his students to do the same by organizing legendary sketch trips to West Texas Reaugh also earned the title of Renaissance man by inventing a portable easel that allowed him to paint in high winds and developing a formula for pastels which he marketed A founder of the Dallas Art Society which became the Dallas Museum of Art Reaugh was central to Dallas and Oak Cliff artistic circles for many years until infighting and politics drove him out of fashion He died isolated and poor in 1945 The last decade has seen a resurgence of interest in Reaugh through gallery shows exhibitions and a recent documentary Despite his importance and this growing public profile however **Rounded Up in Glory** is the first full length biography Michael Grauer argues for Reaugh s importance as more than just a longhorn painter Reaugh s works and far reaching imagination earned him a prominent place in the Texas art pantheon

Saving San Antonio Lewis F. Fisher, 2016-08-22 Few American cities enjoy the likes of San Antonio s visual links with its dramatic past The Alamo and four other Spanish missions recently marked as a UNESCO World Heritage site are the most obvious but there are a host of landmarks and folkways that have survived over the course of nearly three centuries that still lend San Antonio an odd and antiquated foreignness Adding to the charm of the nation s seventh largest city is the San Antonio River saved to become a winding linear park through the

heart of downtown and beyond and a world model for sensitive urban development San Antonio's heritage has not been preserved by accident The wrecking balls and headlong development that accompanied progress in nineteenth century San Antonio roused an indigenous historic preservation movement the first west of the Mississippi River to become effective Its thrust has increased since the mid 1920s with the pioneering work of the San Antonio Conservation Society In *Saving San Antonio* Texas historian Lewis Fisher peels back the myths surrounding more than a century of preservation triumphs and failures to reveal a lively mosaic that portrays the saving of San Antonio's cultural and architectural soul The process entertaining in the telling has reverberated throughout the United States and provided significant lessons for the built environments and economies of cities everywhere
