Howard, 2012-01-27 The three volume work *Perceiving in Depth* is a sequel to *Binocular Vision and Stereopsis* and to *Seeing in Depth* both by Ian P Howard and Brian J Rogers This work is much broader in scope than the previous books and includes mechanisms of depth perception by all senses including aural electrosensory organs and the somatosensory system Volume 1 reviews sensory coding psychophysical and analytic procedures and basic visual mechanisms Volume 2 reviews stereoscopic vision Volume 3 reviews all mechanisms of depth perception other than stereoscopic vision The three volumes are extensively illustrated and referenced and provide the most detailed review of all aspects of perceiving the three dimensional world Volume 1 starts with a review of the history of visual science from the ancient Greeks to the early 20th century with special attention devoted to the discovery of the principles of perspective and stereoscopic vision The first chapter also contains an account of early visual display systems such as panoramas and peepshows and the development of stereoscopes and stereophotography A chapter on the psychophysical and analytic procedures used in investigations of depth perception is followed by a chapter on sensory coding and the geometry of visual space An account of the structure and physiology of the primate visual system proceeds from the eye through the LGN to the visual cortex and higher visual centers This is followed by a review of the evolution of visual systems and of the development of the mammalian visual system in the embryonic and post natal periods with an emphasis on experience dependent neural plasticity An account of the development of perceptual functions especially depth perception is followed by a review of the effects of early visual deprivation during the critical period of neural plasticity on amblyopia and other defects in depth perception Volume 1 ends with accounts of the accommodation mechanism of the human eye and vergence eye movements

Advances in sensing signal processing and computer technology during the past half century have stimulated numerous attempts to design general purpose machines that see These attempts have met with at best modest success and more typically outright failure The difficulties encountered in building working computer vision systems based on state of the art techniques came as a surprise Perhaps the most frustrating aspect of the problem is that machine vision systems cannot deal with numerous visual tasks that humans perform rapidly and effortlessly In reaction to this perceived discrepancy in performance various researchers notably Marr 1982 suggested that the design of machine vision systems should be based on principles drawn from the study of biological systems This neuro morphic or anthropomorphic approach has proven fruitful the use of pyramid multiresolution image representation methods in image compression is one example of a successful application based on principles primarily derived from the study of biological vision systems It is still the case however that the performance of computer vision systems falls far short of that of the natural systems because they are intended to mimic suggesting that it is time to look even more closely at the remaining differences between artificial and biological vision systems

Three-dimensional Kinematics of the Eye, Head and Limb Movements M Fetter, T Haslwanter, H Misslich, D Tweed, 1997-09-09

The 19th century pioneers of motor physiology Helmholtz Hering Fick and others used the mathematics of motion known as kinematics to describe the laws of human movement and to deduce the neural control principles underlying these laws After long neglect partly due to limitations in stimulation and recording techniques the kinematic approach is now resurging fortified with modern computers and electrophysiology New developments in recording techniques as well as an improved understanding of the complex control properties of three dimensional movements have led to a flood of new research in this area The classical laws of Donders and Listing have been confirmed and generalized and computer simulations of the neural control of three dimensional movement have been developed and tested In this book some

of the world's leading scientists of motor control discuss how the brain represents and transforms the kinematic variables of movement. Background chapters explain the basic concepts: non-commutativity, redundancy, and the classical laws and their application to normal function and motor disorders, and shorter articles describe current research. The contributions are based on presentations at a symposium held in Tübingen in August 1995. The wide scope of the book should enable researchers to gain an overview of current research but should also help newcomers to the field to get a good understanding of the questions and problems involved in three-dimensional movement control.

Parallel Processing in the Visual System

Jonathan Stone, 2013-03-08. In the mid sixties John Robson and Christina Enroth Cugell, without realizing what they were doing, set off a virtual revolution in the study of the visual system. They were trying to apply the methods of linear systems analysis, which were already being used to describe the optics of the eye and the psychophysical performance of the human visual system, to the properties of retinal ganglion cells in the cat. Their idea was to stimulate the retina with patterns of stripes and to look at the way that the signals from the center and the antagonistic surround of the receptive field of each ganglion cell first described by Stephen Kuffler interact to generate the cell's responses. Many of the ganglion cells behaved themselves very nicely, and John and Christina got into the habit they now say of calling them "interesting cells." However, to their annoyance, the majority of neurons they recorded had nasty nonlinear properties that couldn't be predicted on the basis of simple summation of light within the center and the surround. These uncooperative ganglion cells, which Enroth Cugell and Robson at first called "dull cells," produced transient bursts of impulses every time the distribution of light falling on the receptive field was changed, even if the total light flux was unaltered.
