Blind Jump The Story Of Shaike Dan:

Blind Jump: The Story of Shaike Dan Amos Ettinger, 2023-12-26 Shaike Dan was one of thirty two Jews from Palestine who volunteered to parachute behind enemy lines in Romania on behalf of British Intelligence during World War II Some of them parachuted into Yugoslavia linked up with partisan forces and stole across frontiers with the help of local smugglers Many of these volunteers were caught and some of them never returned Shaike Dan decided on a blind jump so as not to depend on smugglers Ever since that first jump Shaike Dan's life has been a series of blind jumps Through the friends he made during the war who over the years became key figures in the security services of Eastern European countries he had access to the highest levels of those Communist regimes Thus began his remarkable career of rescuing Jews from behind the Iron Curtain and shipping weapons clandestinely to the new State of Israel This is the story of the amazing exploits of Shaike Dan who volunteered during World War II to parachute behind enemy lines in Romania on behalf of British Intelligence His jump had two objectives 1 to locate the prison camp where 1 400 Allied Air Force crewmen were being held and 2 to try rescuing Jews from Eastern Europe and getting them to Palestine With the publication of his life's story the curtain goes up on the astounding tale of a modern day Pimpernel Menorah Review In 1935 youthful Zionist Shaike Dan left his Romanian village for life on a Palestinian kibbutz Almost a decade later at British request he parachuted behind Nazi lines to rescue prisoners and facilitate the mass departure of East European Jews for the Promised Land Relying primarily on Dan's own words and recollections the author then turns to post war Israel where his subject s contacts chutzpah and organizational legerdemain became crucial in supplying the emerging nation with both population and weaponry Mark R Yerburgh Library Nazi Secret Warfare in Occupied Persia (Iran) Adrian O'Sullivan, 2014-08-05 This is the first full length work to be **Journal** published about the spectacular failure of the German intelligence services in Persia Iran during WWII Based on archival research it analyzes a compelling history of Nazi planning operations personalities and intrigues and follows the protagonists from Hitler's rise to power into the postwar era *Justice Not Vengeance: Recollections* Simon Wiesenthal, 2024-09-05 The beloved and reviled Nazi hunter pens his life story and a riveting one it is Born in Galicia one of the most war ravaged territories in the world he miraculously survived World War II with more than one hair s breadth escape Since that time he has been occupied mainly with tracking down Nazi war criminals who have gone into hiding and in pushing through publicity reluctant German and Austrian officials to bring war criminals to justice the book consists of mainly a miscellany of cases and questions that have engaged the 81 year old Mr Wiesenthal who has lived in Vienna since the war through the course of his unique career Above all it contains the story of how after 12 years of tracking him down he was able to point his finger at Adolf Eichmann then living pseudonymously in Argentina so that the Israelis could kidnap him for trial and eventual execution But apart from successes such as this one Mr Wiesenthal s book contains histories of Nazi war criminals whose whereabouts have not yet been discovered or who have remained unattainable in spite of his efforts this book may best be
