The Airlift would technically continue until September but for all intents and purposes the first crisis of the Cold War had come to an end and most importantly the confrontation remained cold. For the next decade West Berlin remained a haven for highly educated East Germans who wanted freedom and a better life in the West and this brain drain was threatening the survival of the East German economy.
