processing of information obtained through the senses The five sensory systems are sight hearing smell touch and taste that allow information to be collected from the environment Perception is the process that the mind uses to organize the sensory information into an understandable interpretation of the environment Central to all these skills is a critically thinking Marine whose decisions can be affected by numerous factors both external and internal The Marine refines his decision making capabilities by understanding the decision cycle process and his awareness of the physical and biological responses he goes through when faced with a dynamic situation Refining these skills and understanding the effects they have on his mind and body make him more capable and more lethal
