the war Even then SS Officers and contingents from Goring s brigades loaded art from discovered ricoveri into trucks and drove them to northern Italy which was under complete German control and occupation The storage locations for the looted art were kept secret from the Italians until the war ended As the Allies approached the great city of Florence the withdrawing Nazis mined and destroyed some of the most precious medieval and renaissance buildings and bridges
