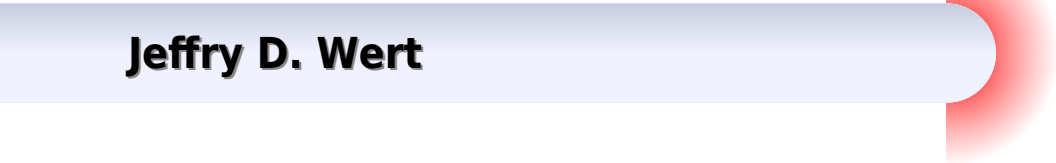

Hess, 2016-07-11 The Civil War's single shot muzzle loading musket revolutionized warfare or so we've been told for years Noted historian Earl J Hess forcefully challenges that claim offering a new clear eyed and convincing assessment of the rifle musket's actual performance on the battlefield and its impact on the course of the Civil War Many contemporaries were impressed with the new weapon's increased range of 500 yards compared to the smoothbore musket's range of 100 yards and assumed that the rifle was a major factor in prolonging the Civil War Historians have also assumed that the weapon dramatically increased casualty rates made decisive victories rare and relegated cavalry and artillery to far lesser roles than they played in smoothbore battles Hess presents a completely new assessment of the rifle musket contending that its impact was much more limited than previously supposed and was confined primarily to marginal operations such as skirmishing and sniping He argues further that its potential to alter battle line operations was virtually nullified by inadequate training soldiers preference for short range firing and the difficulty of seeing the enemy at a distance He notes that bullets fired from the new musket followed a parabolic trajectory unlike those fired from smoothbores at mid range those rifle balls flew well above the enemy creating two killing zones between which troops could operate untouched He also presents the most complete discussion to date of the development of skirmishing and sniping in the Civil War Drawing upon the observations and reflections of the soldiers themselves Hess offers the most compelling argument yet made regarding the actual use of the rifle musket and its influence on Civil War combat Engagingly written and meticulously researched his book will be of special interest to Civil War scholars buffs re-enactors and gun enthusiasts alike *The American Civil War* Ian Frederick Finseth, 2006 This anthology brings together a wide variety of both well known and more obscure writing from and about the Civil War along with supplementary appendices to facilitate its use in courses The selections include short fiction poetry public addresses diary entries song lyrics and essays from such figures as Walt Whitman Ambrose Bierce Stephen Crane and Louisa May Alcott as well as Abraham Lincoln Frederick Douglass Jefferson Davis and Ulysses S Grant The writing not only includes those directly involved in the war but also those writing about the war afterward to include the perspective of historical memory This collection makes a perfect addition to any course on Civil War history or literature as well as courses on popular memory *In Pursuit of a Phantom* Arnold M. opened on May 1 1864 While Grant and Lee grappled with one another like wrestlers Sherman and Johnston parried and feinted like fencers Johnston eschewed the offensive while hoping to lure Sherman into headlong assaults against fortified lines Sherman disliked the uncertainty of battle and preferred maneuvering When Johnston dug in Sherman sought his flanks and turned the Confederates out of seemingly impregnable positions in a campaign noted Civil War historian Richard M McMurry dubbed the Red Clay Minuet Contrary to popular belief Sherman did not set out to capture Atlanta His orders were to move against Johnston s army to break it up and to get into the interior of the enemy s country inflicting all the damage you can against their war resources No Civil War army could survive long without its logistical base and Atlanta was vital to the larger Confederate war effort As Johnston retreated Southern fears for the city grew As Sherman advanced Northern expectations increased This first installment of The Atlanta Campaign relies on a mountain of primary source material and extensive experience with the terrain to examine the battles of Dalton Resaca Rome Crossroads Adairsville and Cassville the first phase of the long and momentous campaign While none of these engagements matched the bloodshed of the Wilderness or Spotsylvania each witnessed periods of intense fighting and key decision making The largest fight Resaca produced more than 8 000 killed wounded and missing in just two days In between these actions the armies skirmished daily in a campaign its participants would recall as the 100 days fight Like Powell s The Chickamauga Campaign trilogy this multi volume study breaks new ground and promises to be this generation s definitive treatment of one of the most important and fascinating confrontations of the entire Civil War

Sand, Science, and the Civil War Scott Hippensteel, 2023-03-15 The influence of sedimentary geology on the strategy combat and tactics of the American Civil War is a subject that has been neglected by military historians Sedimentary geology influenced everything from the nature of the landscape flat vs rolling terrain to the effectiveness of the weapons a single grain of sand can render a rifle musket as useless as a club Sand Science and the Civil War investigates the role of sedimentary geology on the campaigns and battles of the Civil War on multiple scales with a special emphasis on the fighting along the coastlines At the start of the Civil War the massive brick citadels guarding key coastal harbors and shipyards were thought to be invincible to artillery attack The Union bombardment of Savannah s key defensive fortification Fort Pulaski demonstrated the vulnerability of this type of fortress to the new rifled artillery available to the Union Fort Pulaski surrendered within a day When the Union later tried to capture the temporary sand fortifications of Battery Wagner protecting Charleston and Fort Fisher protecting Wilmington they employed similar tactics but with disastrous results The value of sand in defensive positions vastly minimized the Federal advantage in artillery making these coastal strongpoints especially costly to capture Through this geologically centered historic lens Scott Hippensteel explores the way sediments and sedimentary rocks influenced the fighting in all theaters of war and how geologic resources were exploited by both sides during the five years of conflict
