balance where the person can become whole The search for wholeness feeds from cultural roots that imply the presence of ancestral spiritualism rememory and double consciousness Contemporary black women writers reflect the metaphor of building spiritual bridges seeking the possibilities of building a bridge to the archetypal African past that is carried in their memories as a presence that offers sustenance via spiritual reconnection Their works seek to bridge the gap between the myths and traditions of the past and contemporary African American culture The texts included in this collection are examples of writing as an exercise of what V v Clark calls Diaspora literacy The texts written by contemporary African American women writers explicitly show how to recognize and read the cultural signs left scattered along the road of progress In this way material acquisition is achieved along with cultural dispossession becoming a metaphor for the history of the African in America The powerful message is that one should not exclude the other Red. White, and Black Make Blue Andrea Feeser, 2013 Like cotton indigo has defied its humble origins Left alone it might have been a regional plant with minimal reach a localized way of dyeing textiles paper and other goods with a bit of blue But when blue became the most popular color for the textiles that Britain turned out in large quantities in the eighteenth century the South Carolina indigo that colored most of this cloth became a major component in transatlantic commodity chains In Red White and Black Make Blue Andrea Feeser tells the stories of all the peoples who made indigo a key part of the colonial South Carolina experience as she explores indigo s relationships to land use slave labor textile production and use sartorial expression and fortune building In the eighteenth century indigo played a central role in the development of South Carolina The popularity of the color blue among the upper and lower classes ensured a high demand for indigo and the climate in the region proved sound for its cultivation Cheap labor by slaves both black and Native American made commoditization of indigo possible And due to land grabs by colonists from the enslaved or expelled indigenous peoples the expansion into the backcountry made plenty of land available on which to cultivate the crop Feeser recounts specific histories uncovered for the first time during her research of how the Native Americans and African slaves made the success of indigo in South Carolina possible She also emphasizes the material culture around particular objects including maps prints paintings and clothing Red White and Black Make Blue is a fraught and compelling history of both exploitation and empowerment revealing the legacy of a modest plant with an outsized impact Gullah Culture in America Wilbur Cross, 2007-12-30 In 1989 1998 and 2005 fifteen Gullah speakers went to Sierra Leone and other parts of West Africa to trace their origins and ancestry Their journey frames this exploration of the extraordinary history of the Gullah culture characterized by strong African cultural retention and a direct influence on American culture particularly in the South described in this fascinating book Since long before the Revolution America has had hidden pockets of a bygone African culture with a language of its own and long endowed with traditions language design medicine agriculture fishing hunting weaving and the arts This book explores the Gullah culture s direct link to Africa via the sea islands of the American southeast The first published evidence of Gullah went almost unrecorded until
