The Case for Conservatism Francis Graham Wilson, 1990-01-01 Conservative and liberal political impulses have contended throughout the history of the United States although there are no major Conservative or Liberal parties in the United States Instead the terms signify general inclinations and prejudices encouraged to some degree within all major political parties As Russell Kirk notes in his introduction throughout the nineteenth century public men generally professed conservative assumptions whatever their practical policies Only with the ascent of Franklin Delano Roosevelt and continuing to recent years did liberalism begin to predominate in morals and politics Francis Wilson's slim volume was an expression of intellectual renewal of conservative ideas in the post World War II period Initially published in 1951 it gave expression to the body of common belief that then and now constitutes the essence of conservatism Lucid and temperate he outlines the

principles to which conservatives subscribe and how they have changed Published in Russell Kirk's Library of Conservative Thought series The Case for Conservatism has continuing relevance to those who would understand the intellectual roots of the contemporary revival of conservative public policies

Liberalism and Value Pluralism George Crowder, 2002-04-30 Value pluralism is the idea associated with the late Isaiah Berlin that fundamental human values are irreducibly plural and incommensurable Ends like liberty equality and community are intrinsic goods which can neither be ranked in an absolute hierarchy nor translated into units of a common denominator If that is true how can we choose among such values when they come into conflict in particular cases In particular what reason is there to justify the value ranking characteristic of liberal democracy favouring personal autonomy and toleration Recent commentators have seen value pluralism as undermining the traditional claims of liberalism to universal authority rendering it at best no more than one political form among others with no greater claim to legitimacy Against that view George Crowder argues that a strong distinctive case for liberalism as a universal project is implied by value pluralism itself Reflection on the elements of value pluralism yields a set of ethical principles including respect for universal values rejection of political utopianism promotion of value diversity accommodation of reasonable disagreement and cultivation of civic virtues Those principles are best satisfied by a liberal form of politics characterised by a strong commitment to personal autonomy by policies of moderate redistribution and multiculturalism and by constitutional restraints on democratic politics This is the first book length defence of liberalism on the basis of value pluralism complementing and extending the work of Berlin and others

Conservatives Clash Bruce Edward Fleming, 2006 Why Liberals and Conservatives Clash offers an explanation for the extreme polarization between liberal and conservative that is the hallmark of the American political landscape today It suggests that liberal thought is intrinsically different from conservative thought and that each constitutes a self subsistent world view with its specific qualities and rules The book offers a set of guidelines to predict a person's views based on other views s he holds given that each world view is what it is for structural reasons and is more than merely a sum of discrete positions It explains for example why people who support gay marriage also typically support the woman's right to an early term abortion and why people who demand that citizens support the military understand this as meaning support putting members of the military in harm's way Because liberal thought and conservative thought each constitutes a closed world view neither side will ever convince the other in an argument The most we can hope for is an acknowledgment by each side of the usefulness of the other a goal Fleming proposes as the most reasonable one for our times Why Liberals and Conservatives Clash makes logical the most striking and hitherto puzzling feature of the contemporary American political landscape its acrimony its air of being an argument between the deaf neither side understands the other Fleming suggests this is so because neither side accepts the bases underlying the other's particular positions We can however understand that they are different and that trying to force the other side into submission won't work We need to go beyond liberals dismissing conservatives with horror and conservatives dismissing liberals with disgust Conservatives aren't merely imperfect liberals they're something else entirely Liberals aren't merely potential conservatives they actually think differently
