In addition, whereas ideological concepts being expressed about what is good, just, and appropriate often are delineated geographically, the transgression of these delineations reveals the normally hidden relationships between place and ideology. In other words, the out of place serves to highlight and define the in place. By looking at the transgressions of the marginalized, Cresswell argues, we can gain a novel perspective on the normal and taken-for-granted expectations of everyday life. The book concludes with a consideration of the possibility of a politics of transgression, arguing for a link between the challenging of spatial boundaries and the possibility of social transformation.
