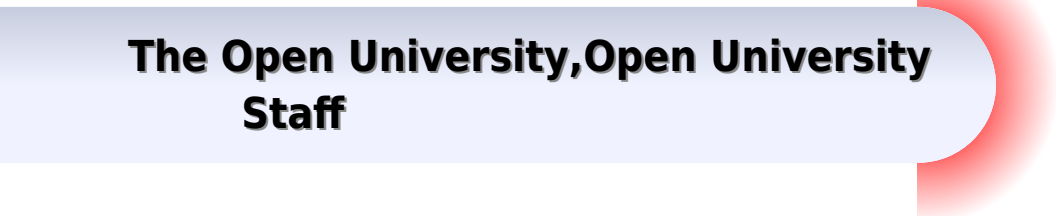

Art in Mediaeval France 987-1498 Joan Evans, 1948 **The Illustrated Afterlife of Terence's Comedies (800-1200)** Beatrice Radden Keefe, 2021-08-30 Widely read as school texts the comedies by the Roman dramatist Terence have come down to us in hundreds of medieval copies Fourteen of the manuscripts produced between 800 and 1200 were given some kind of illustration In this volume Beatrice Radden Keefe explores the semiotics of the imagery found in the earliest illustrated Terence manuscripts and its relationship to the iconography of comedy and theatre from antiquity She examines six further manuscripts to show how later illustrators abandoned this imagery to varying degrees finding new emphases and creating new layers of meaning Illustrators of Terence it is demonstrated here brought a range of interests to illustrating the comedies clarifying their narrative incorporating social commentary and moralisation and linking them with Christian allegorical traditions The Year 1200 Konrad Hoffmann, 1970 *Reading Medieval Images* Elizabeth Sears, Thelma K. Thomas, 2002 What is it that art historians do when they approach works of art What kind of language do they use to describe what they see How do they construct arguments using visual evidence What sorts of arguments do they make In this unusual anthology eighteen prominent art historians specializing in the medieval field European Byzantine and Islamic provide answers to these fundamental questions not directly but by way of example Each author responding to invitation has chosen for study a single image or object and has submitted it to sustained analysis The collection of essays accompanied by statements on methodology by the editors offers an accessible introduction to current art historical practice Elizabeth L Sears is Associate Professor of the History of Art University of Michigan Thelma K Thomas is Associate Professor of the History of Art and Associate Curator of the Kelsey Museum University of Michigan Fashion in the Age of the Black Prince Stella Mary Newton, 1999 A close study of clothes worn by aristocratic families and their households at the time of the Black Prince and of Chaucer showing Europe wide influences 1340 to 1363 were years remarkable for dramatic developments in fashion and for extravagant spending on costume foreshadowing the later luxury of Richard II's court Stella Mary Newton broke new ground with this detailed study which discusses fourteenth century costume in detail She draws on surviving accounts from the Royal courts the evidence of chronicles and poetry often from unpublished manuscripts and representations in painting sculpture and manuscript illumination Her exploration of aspects of chivalry particularly the choice of mottoes and devices worn at tournaments and of the exchange of gifts of clothing between reigning monarchs offers new insights into the social history of the times and she has much to say that is relevant to the study of illuminated manuscripts of the fourteenth century STELLA MARY NEWTON's lifelong interest in costume has been the mainspring of her work from early days as a stage and costume designer including designing the costumes for the first production of T S Eliot's *Murder in the Cathedral* to her later work at the National Gallery advising on the implications of costume for the purpose of dating and at the Courtauld Institute where she set up the department for the study of the history of dress *Viewing*
