Vietnamese Language, Education and Change In and Outside Vietnam Phan Le Ha, Dat Bao, Joel Windle, 2024-05-21 This open access edited book attempts to break new ground in investigating multiple facets of Vietnamese language education and change in global contexts engaging with global Vietnam through complex lenses of language and education Issues of language globalization and global identities have often been framed through the lens of hierarchical binary power relations and or through a dichotomy between hyper central languages such as English and revisualized or
