Blowback Neil DeVotta, 2004 In the mid 1950s Sri Lanka's majority Sinhalese politicians began outbidding one another on who could provide the greatest advantages for their community using the Sinhala language as their instrument The appeal to Sinhalese linguistic nationalism precipitated a situation in which the movement to replace English as the country's official language with Sinhala and Tamil the language of Sri Lanka's principal minority was abandoned and Sinhala alone became the official language in 1956 The Tamils subsequent protests led to anti Tamil riots and institutional decay which meant that supposedly representative agencies of government catered to Sinhalese preferences and blatantly disregarded minority interests This in turn led to the Tamils mobilizing first politically then militarily and by the mid 1970s Tamil youth were bent on creating a separate state

The Political Economy of Ethnic Conflict in Sri Lanka Nikolaos Biziouras, 2014-03-26 At the point of independence in 1948 Sri Lanka was projected to be a success story in the developing world However in July 1983 a violent ethnic conflict which pitted the Sinhalese against the Tamils began and did not come to an end until 2009 This conflict led to nearly 50 000 combatant deaths and approximately 40 000 civilian deaths as well as almost 1 million internally displaced refugees and to the permanent migration abroad of nearly 130 000 civilians With a focus on Sri Lanka this book explores the political economy of ethnic conflict and examines how rival political leaders are able to convince their ethnic group members to follow them into violent conflict Specifically it looks at how political leaders can influence and utilize changes in the level of economic liberalization in order to mobilize members of a certain ethnic group and in the case of Sri Lanka shows how ethnic mobilization drives can turn violent when minority ethnic groups are economically marginalized by the decisions that the majority ethnic group leaders make in order to stay in power Taking a political economy approach to the conflict in Sri Lanka this book is unique in its historical analysis and provides a longitudinal view of the evolution of both Tamil and Sinhalese ethnic drives As such this interdisciplinary study will be of interest to policy makers as well as academics in the field of South Asian studies political science sociology development studies political economy and security studies

The Separatist Conflict in Sri Lanka Asoka Bandarage, 2008-11-19 The book provides a detailed historically based analysis of the origin evolution and potential resolution of the civil conflict in Sri Lanka over the struggle to establish a separate state in its Northern and Eastern provinces This conflict between the Sri Lankan government and the secessionist LTTE Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam is one of the world's most intractable contemporary armed struggles The internationally banned LTTE is considered the prototype of modern terrorism It is known to have introduced suicide bombing to the world and recently became the first terrorist organization ever to acquire an air force The iron law of ethnicity the assumption that cultural difference inevitably leads to conflict has been reinforced by the 9 11 attacks and conflicts like the one in Sri Lanka However the connections among ethnic difference conflict and terrorism are not automatic This book broadens the discourse on the separatist conflict in Sri Lanka by moving beyond the familiar bipolar Sinhala versus Tamil

ethnic antagonism to show how the form and content of ethnicity are shaped by historical social forces. It develops a multipolar analysis which takes into account diverse ethnic groups, intra ethnic social class, caste and other variables at the local, regional and international levels. Overall, this book presents a conceptual framework useful for comparative global conflict analysis and resolution, shedding light on a host of complex issues such as terrorism, civil society, diasporas, international intervention and secessionism.

Autonomy and Ethnic Conflict in South and South-East Asia Rajat Ganguly, 2013-05-20. This book uses empirical evidence from various case studies to examine the relationship between territorial and regional autonomy, the nation state and ethnic conflict resolution in South and South East Asia. The concept of territorial or regional autonomy holds centre stage in the literature on ethnic conflict settlement because it is supposed to be able to reconcile two paradoxical objectives: the preservation of the territorial integrity and sovereignty of the state and the satisfaction of ethnic minorities' right to national self-determination. Critics argue, however, that autonomy may not be the panacea for ethnic conflict in all cases. The contributing authors begin with the concept of territorial or regional autonomy and subject it to a rigorous empirical analysis which provides reliable evidence regarding the suitability of the autonomy solution to intractable ethnic conflicts. Drawing upon case studies from Kashmir, Assam, Sri Lanka, Aceh, Mindanao and Southern Thailand, this edited volume argues that autonomy arrangements may at best work to resolve only a handful of separatist ethnic conflicts in South and South East Asia. This book will be of much interest to students of South and South East Asia, Asian security, ethnic conflict, peace studies and IR in general.

Ethnic Subnationalist Insurgencies in South Asia Jugdep S. Chima, 2015-03-24. This book provides a micro-historical analysis of the emergence and contemporary dynamics of recent ethnic sub-nationalist insurgencies in South Asia. Using comparative case studies, it discusses the causes of each insurgency, analyses the trajectory and dynamics of each, including attempts at resolution, and highlights the wider theories of ethno-nationalist insurgency and mobilization. Bringing together an international group of contributors, the book covers insurgencies in India, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Nepal and Bangladesh. It questions why ethnic sub-nationalist insurgencies occurred at particular points in time and not at others and explores the comparative trajectories of these movements. The book goes on to discern reappearing patterns of conflict escalation, de-escalation through the method of comparative process tracing. It argues that while identity is a necessary factor for insurgency, it is not a sufficient one. Instead, ethnic mobilization and insurgency only emerge when it is activated by tension emerging from political competition between ethnic and central state elites. These elite-led dynamics, when combined with favourable socio-economic and political conditions, make the ethnic masses primed to accept the often symbolically rich appeals from their leaders to mobilize against the central state. Providing an important study on ethno-nationalist insurgencies in South Asia, the book will be of interest to those working in the fields of South Asian Politics, Security Studies and Ethnic Conflict.

War, Denial and Nation-Building in Sri Lanka Rachel Seoighe, 2017-12-05. This book begins from a critical account of the final months of the Sri Lankan civil war, tracing themes of

nationalism discourse and conflict memory through this period of immense violence and into its aftermath Using these themes to explore state crime atrocity and its denial and representation Seoighe offers an analysis of how stories of conflict are authored and constructed This book examines the political discourse of the former Rajapaksa government highlighting how fluency in international discourses of counter terrorism humanitarianism and the reconciliation expected of states transitioning from conflict can be used to conceal and deny state violence Drawing on extensive interviews with activists academics politicians state representatives and international agency staff and three months of observation in Sri Lanka in 2012 Seoighe demonstrates how the Rajapaksa government re narrativised violence through orchestrated techniques of denial and mass ritual discourse It drew on and perpetuated a heightened majoritarian Sinhala Buddhist nationalism which consolidated power under Sinhalese political elites generated minority grievances and in turn sustained the repression and dispossession of the Tamil community of the Northeast A detailed and evocative study this book will be of special interest to scholars of conflict studies political violence and critical criminology
