films took the industry by storm in the late 1920s there were a numbers of pretenders who reached for the Sherlock Holmes crown including Clive Brook Reginald Owen and Raymond Massey but it took more than a decade before a new definitive Sherlock Holmes would be crowned in 1939 in the person of Basil Rathbone Mystery Fanfare Michael L.
