Armies of the Carthaginian Wars Terence Wise, Richard Hook, 1996 Truceless War, 2007-09-30 The revolt of Carthage's mercenaries and oppressed Libyan subjects in 241 237 BC nearly ended her power and even existence This truceless war unrivalled for its savagery was fought over most of Punic North Africa and spread to Sardinia It brought to power in Carthage Hamilcar Barca father of Hannibal whose generalship though flawed was critical to Carthage's final victory The main narrative by the Greek historian Polybius a century later is vividly evocative inspiring Flaubert's novel Salammbô yet repeatedly unclear on military and geographical details the extent and structure of the rebel coalition and chronology Truceless War analyses Polybius and other sources to present a coherent and absorbing study of the war's causes and events and of Polybius historiographical methods **Cornelius Nepos, Life of Hannibal** Bret Mulligan, 2015-10-05 Trebia Trasimene Cannae With three stunning victories Hannibal humbled Rome and nearly shattered its empire Even today Hannibal's brilliant if ultimately unsuccessful campaign against Rome during the Second Punic War 218 202 BC make him one of history's most celebrated military leaders This biography by Cornelius Nepos c 100 27 BC sketches Hannibal's life from the time he began traveling with his father's army as a young boy through his sixteen year invasion of Italy and his tumultuous political career in Carthage to his perilous exile and eventual suicide in the East As Rome completed its bloody transition from dysfunctional republic to stable monarchy Nepos labored to complete an innovative and influential collection of concise biographies Putting aside the detailed chronological accounts of military campaigns and political machinations that characterized most writing about history Nepos surveyed Roman and Greek history for distinguished men who excelled in a range of prestigious occupations In the exploits and achievements of these illustrious men Nepos hoped that his readers would find models for the honorable conduct of their own lives Although most of Nepos' works have been lost we are fortunate to have his biography of Hannibal Nepos offers a surprisingly balanced portrayal of a man that most Roman authors vilified as the most monstrous foe that Rome had ever faced Nepos' straightforward style and his preference for common vocabulary make Life of Hannibal accessible for those who are just beginning to read continuous Latin prose while the historical interest of the subject make it compelling for readers of every ability **Greek Hoplite 480-323 BC** Nicholas Sekunda, 2000-12-25 The Greek hoplite the archetypal spear armed warrior is perhaps the most prevalent figure in our view of the Golden Age of Ancient Greek civilisation It was during this period that the state began to take greater responsibility for military organisation and the arming and equipping of its citizens From the victory at Marathon over Darius of Persia 490 BC through bitter inter state warfare to the rise of Philip of Macedonia and his son Alexander the Great the hoplite soldier was in the front line This title narrates the life and experiences of the common Greek warrior how he was recruited trained and fought and also looks in detail at how his weapons armour shields and helmets developed in the course of time **US Cavalry on the Plains 1850-90** Philip Katcher, 1985 Two events in the 19th century turned the minds of Americans
