Unnamable Susette Min, 2018-06-05. Redraws the contours of Asian American art attempting to free it from a categorization that stifles more than it reveals. Inspired above all by their art practice, Min argues for an alternative approach to exhibition making and methods of reading that conceives of these works not as exemplary instances of Asian American art but as engaged in an aesthetic practice that remains open ended, challenging the assumptions that racialize artists within an Asian American context. Ultimately, Unnamable insists that in order to reassess Asian American art and beyond its place in art history, we may need to let go not only of established viewing and curatorial practices but potentially even the category of Asian American art itself as we know it.
