and self creation Knafo shows how artists though mostly creating in solitude are frequently engaged in significant relational processes that attempt rapprochement with internalized objects and repair of psychic injury Dancing with the Unconscious expands the theoretical dimension of psychoanalysis while offering the clinician ways to realize greater creativity in work with patients
