both cases anthropomorphism was also concealed or rejected though to a different degree In the present book this dual approach toward the divine image is considered as a reflection of two associated rather than contradictory religious worldviews. The plausible consolidation of the relevant Biblical accounts just before the Babylonian Exile or more probably within the Exile in both cases during a period of strong Assyrian and Babylonian hegemony points to a direct correspondence between comparable religious phenomena. It is suggested that far from their homeland and in the absence of a temple for their god the Judahite deportees adopted and intensified the Mesopotamian avoidance of anthropomorphic picorial portrayals of deities. While the Babylonian representations remained confined to temples the exiles would have turned a cultic reality i e the nonwritten Babylonian custom into a written articulated law that explicity forbade the pictorial representation of God
