Michael Miller, 2020-06-29 The battles of Belleau Wood and Soissons in June and July of 1918 marked a turning point in World War I and in the stature of the US Marine Corps whose fighting proved so critical in repelling the Germans that the French would later rename Belleau Bois de la Brigade de Marine In this book J Michael Miller a historian of the Marine Corps and veteran chronicler of battle takes us to the battlefields of Belleau Wood and Soissons immersing us in the experience of a single brigade of marines at the forefront of the fighting Through a close up look at the doughboys singular impact on Allied victory in 1918 his work illuminates America's bloody sacrifice during World War I The 4th Marine Brigade at Belleau Wood and Soissons for the first time treats these two battles as one campaign and demonstrates why it is impossible to fully understand one without the other Miller outlines the company and platoon levels of combat throughout the campaign establishing a basic tactical understanding of the fighting he also draws on letters diaries memoirs and interviews to create a vivid and personal reconstruction of the battles His use of French and German sources also a first adds unprecedented insights to this boots on the ground account The book includes detailed mapping of both battlefields with a thirty six stop guide linking the text with the actual terrain For each of these stops Miller gives GPS coordinates to provide a virtual tour of the sites he discusses With its strategic overview and ground level perspective Miller's work suggests a new interpretation and offers a new experience of an iconic moment in American military history and in the story of the Marine Corps **Battlefield Tourism** David William Lloyd, 2014-03-04 In the aftermath of the Great War a wave of tourists and pilgrims visited the battlefields cemeteries and memorials of the war

The cultural history of this battlefield tourism is chronicled in this absorbing and original book which shows how the phenomenon served to construct memory in Britain as well as in Australia and Canada The author demonstrates that high and low culture tradition and modernism the sacred and the profane were often inter related rather than polar opposites The various responses to the actual and imagined landscapes of battlefields are discussed as well as bereavement and how this was shaped by gender religion and the military experience Individual memory and experience combined with nationalism and imperial identity as powerful forces informing the pilgrim experience But this book not only analyzes travel to battlefields which unsurprisingly paralleled the growth of the modern tourist industry it also looks closely at the transformation of national war memorials into pilgrimage sites and shows how responses both to battlefields and memorials which continue to serve as potent symbols evolved in the years after the Great War

Wilder,2014-05-06 Amos Wilder s poetry drew from an inexhaustible well of his Christian belief in the destiny of man and nature seeking always to find fresh ways and language to invoke the imperatives of faith and spiritual life in a modern era This collection of thirty five poems the third of Amos Wilder s four books of published poetry appeared in 1942 in the midst of World War II Shaping it to speak to a world in crisis Wilder included five poems republished from his first volume of poetry Battle Retrospect 1923 and twelve poems from his second Arachne 1928 with two major poems revised both conceived under the long shadow of World War I a war in which he had fought The last poem written for this collection Homage is dedicated to his bother Thornton to T N W 1942 then serving with US Army Air Force Intelligence in North Africa

Ebel,2014-02-24 Faith in the Fight tells a story of religion soldiering suffering and death in the Great War Recovering the thoughts and experiences of American troops nurses and aid workers through their letters diaries and memoirs Jonathan Ebel describes how religion primarily Christianity encouraged these young men and women to fight and die sustained them through war s chaos and shaped their responses to

the war's aftermath The book reveals the surprising frequency with which Americans who fought viewed the war as a religious challenge that could lead to individual and national redemption Believing in a Christianity of the sword these Americans responded to the war by reasserting their religious faith and proclaiming America God chosen and righteous in its mission And while the war sometimes challenged these beliefs it did not fundamentally alter them Revising the conventional view that the war was universally disillusioning Faith in the Fight argues that the war in fact strengthened the religious beliefs of the Americans who fought and that it helped spark a religiously charged revival of many prewar orthodoxies during a postwar period marked by race riots labor wars communist witch hunts and gender struggles For many Americans Ebel argues the postwar period was actually one of reillusionment Demonstrating the deep connections between Christianity and Americans experience of the First World War Faith in the Fight encourages us to examine the religious dimensions of America's wars past and present and to work toward a deeper understanding of religion and violence in American history

Pogiebait's War Jack H. McCall,2023-02-03 Jack H McCall Sr was a born storyteller an inveterate practical joker and a proud Tennessean whose flaws included a considerable taste for candy or pogiebait in Marine parlance Like so many other able bodied young people in on the eve of World War II he decided to enlist in the wake of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor Much more than a family memoir or nostalgic wartime reminiscence this painstakingly researched biography presents a rich engaging study of the U S Marine Corps particularly McCall s understudied unit the Ninth Defense Battalion the Fighting Ninth The author provides a window into the day to day service of a Marine during World War II with important coverage of fighting in the Pacific Theater McCall also depicts life in wartime Franklin Tennessee and offers a poignant and personal tribute to his father McCall dramatizes some of the classic themes of the war memoir genre war is hell but memories fade but he sets riveting descriptions of decisive action against rarely seen views of mundane work and daily life supported with maps photographs and fresh interpretations Another distinction of this work is its attention to the action on Guam a very unpleasant late war mopping up that has received relatively little scholarly attention In his portrait of the bitter island hopping war in the Pacific the author shows how both U S and Japanese soldiers were often eager innocents drawn to the cauldron of conflict and indoctrinated and trained by their respective governments Reflecting on the action late in life Jack as well as several other Ninth veterans came to a begrudging respect for the enemy

Theology and Modern Literature Amos N. Wilder,2014-05-06 We live in a world that calls for the separation of church and state and the separation of religion and the arts is of a piece with this divided culture However this long standing breach between Christianity and the

arts narrows in view of the notable development of mutual interest and conversation between theology and literature Dr Wilder discusses this historic cleavage and then sets forth first from the side of imaginative literature and then from the side of the church the evidence for an emerging bridge of this gulf The most significant arts of our time have dealt with metaphysical and moral themes as well as existential concerns by drawing on the great religious mythical patterns of the past Yet the church in many respects has become conscious of its aesthetic shortcomings and is increasingly aware of the modern arts Dr Wilder discusses the basic dilemma of Christianity's relationship to the aesthetic order of experience emphasizing that religious art and symbols should not be viewed as merely decoration but rather as bearers of meaning and truth and therefore as critically important to the religious tradition Dr Wilder examines particular examples of the treatment of religious subject matter in modern works by Jeffers and Faulkner He reflects on Jeffers' adequate and inadequate views of the central Christian theme of vicarious atonement and takes Faulkner's *The Sound and the Fury* as opportunity for consideration of the attenuation of Christian culture The book aims to inform readers interested in modern literature and the arts of relevant developments in church circles that may both surprise and gratify even as it introduces churchmen and theologians to features of modern writing that very much concern them

American Soldiers Peter S. Kindsvatter, 2003-04-03 Some warriors are drawn to the thrill of combat and find it the defining moment of their lives Others fall victim to fear exhaustion impaired reasoning and despair This was certainly true for twentieth century American ground troops Whether embracing or being demoralized by war these men risked their lives for causes larger than themselves with no promise of safe return This book is the first to synthesize the wartime experiences of American combat soldiers from the doughboys of World War I to the grunts of Vietnam Focusing on both soldiers and marines it draws on histories and memoirs oral histories psychological and sociological studies and even fiction to show that their experiences remain fundamentally the same regardless of the enemy terrain training or weaponry Peter Kindsvatter gets inside the minds of American soldiers to reveal what motivated them to serve and how they were turned into soldiers He recreates the physical and emotional aspects of war to tell how fighting men dealt with danger and hardship and he explores

the roles of comradeship leadership and the sustaining beliefs in cause and country He also illuminates soldiers attitudes toward the enemy toward the rear echelon and toward the home front And he tells why some broke down under fire while others excelled Here are the first tastes of battle as when a green recruit reported that for the first time I realized that the people over the ridge wanted to kill me while another was befuddled by the unfamiliar sound of bullets whizzing overhead Here are soldiers struggling to cope with war s stress by seeking solace from local women or simply smoking cigarettes And here are tales of combat avoidance and fraggings not unique to Vietnam of soldiers in Korea disgruntled over home front indifference and of the unique experiences of African American soldiers in the Jim Crow army By capturing the core band of brothers experience across several generations of warfare Kindsvatter celebrates the American soldier while helping us to better understand war s lethal reality and why soldiers persevere in the face of its horrors Stephen Vincent Benet David Garrett Izzo, Lincoln Konkle, 2002-12-23 When Stephen Vincent Benet died in 1943 at the age of 44 all of America mourned the loss Benet was one of the country s most well known poets of the first half of the twentieth century and as a fiction writer he had an even larger audience This book is a collection of essays celebrating Benet and his writing The first group of essays addresses Benet s life times and personal relationships Thomas Carr Benet reminisces about his father in the first essay and others consider Benet s marriage to his wife Rosemary Archibald MacLeish Thornton Wilder and Benet as friends liberal humanists and public activists and his friendships with Philip Barry Jed Harris and Thornton Wilder The second group contains essays about Benet s poetry fiction and drama They discuss Benet s role in the development of historical poetry in America John Brown s Body and the Civil War Hawthorne Benet and historical fiction Benet s Faustian America the adaptation of The Devil and Daniel Webster to drama and then to film Benet s use of fantasy and science fiction and Benet as a dramatist for stage screen and radio **The Life and Times of a World War I Soldier** Clyde Cremer, 2014 Julius Holthaus a humble American farm boy went to France to help fill the depleted ranks of the Allies in America s largest battle of World War I the Meuse Argonne Offensive He had no idea what he was getting into The fight would involve more than a million American doughboys span forty seven days and result in the deaths of tens of thousands of people in one of the bloodiest battle in American military history Countless books focus on great military leaders war heroes and battle tactics but one must look at war on a human scale to truly understand its toll That understanding comes through examining the life and diary of Holthaus Author Clyde Cremer explores them in detail supplementing the diary s information with the insights he gleaned during six years of research This history follows a single soldier from rural Idaho and Iowa through his enlistment training and final trauma in the dark disenchanted forest of the Argonne Filled with facts and historical anecdotes this could be the story of many of the members of the American Expeditionary Forces sent overseas in World War I Their names are not listed in the history books but they all answered their country s call and should be remembered Parameters , 1994
