VCs of the First World War: Cambrai 1917 Gerald Gliddon, 2012-02-29 Featuring the careers of forty three men this volume tells the story of the Battle of Cambrai famous for being the first occasion when tanks were used en masse in battle Its first day was so successful that church bells in Britain were rung in anticipation of a great victory A tank crewman numbers among the recipients of the VC Containing biographies of a broad cross section of men from Britain and the Dominions including Canada Australia New Zealand and even the Ukraine It includes a sapper a former miner who chose to stay with his seriously wounded colleague underground and die with him rather than obey an order to leave him and save his own life a maverick lieutenant colonel who was relieved of his command and a padre who worked tirelessly over a period of three nights bringing at least twenty five men to safety from No Man s Land who otherwise would have been left to die

Arras and Messines, 1917 Gerald Gliddon, 2012 For much of the First World War the opposing armies on the Western Front were at a stalemate with an unbroken line of fortified trenches stretching from the Belgian coast to the Swiss border The Allied objective after the bloody Battle of the Somme drew to a close in November 1916 was to decisively break through the German Hindenburg Line and engage the numerically inferior German forces in a war of movement The Arras offensive was conceived to achieve this breakthrough and was planned for early 1917 after considerable pressure from the French High Command Commonwealth Forces advanced on a broad front between Vimy in the northwest and Bullecourt in the southeast with the French Army attacking 80km further south in the Aisne area Initial successes albeit costly were followed by a reversion to the previous stalemate and lead to a change of focus with an assault on the Messines Ridge near Ypres beginning in June 1917 By the end of July on the eve of the Third Battle of Ypres a total of fifty Victoria Crosses had been awarded including many troops from the Australian Canadian and New Zealand Forces This includes Captain Robert Greive who single handedly silenced two enemy machine gun nests at Messines and L Cpl James Welch who captured four prisoners with an empty revolver The courage determination and sacrifice of their generation should never be forgotten Gerald Gliddon is a notable historian author and bookseller specialising in military history He has written a number of books about the First World War and has coordinated this series Among his many titles are Somme 1916 A Battlefield Guide The History Press He lives in Norfolk

Arras & Messines, 1917 Gerald Gliddon, 1998 Covering the period January to July 1917 much of this book concentrates on the events of April the month of the Battle of Arras By the end of July a total of 50 Victoria Crosses had been awarded This text records the life and military career of each of the recipients

Fallen: Arras North Peter Hughes, 2015-05-30 Like Ypres Arras was a front line town throughout the Great War From March 1916 it became home to the British Army and it remained so until the Advance to Victory was well under way In 1917 the Battle of Arras came and went It occupied barely half a season but was then largely forgotten the periods before and after it have been virtually ignored and yet the Arras sector was always important and holding it was never easy or without incident death of course was never far away The area around Arras is as rich in Commonwealth War Graves Commission cemeteries as anywhere else on the Western Front including the Somme and Ypres and yet these quiet redoubts with their headstones proudly on parade still remain largely unvisited This book is the story of the men who fell and who are now buried in those cemeteries and the telling of their story is the telling of what it was like to be a soldier on the Western Front Arras North is the first of three books by the same author This volume contains in depth coverage of almost sixty Commonwealth War Graves Commission cemeteries and is a veritable Who's Who of officers and other ranks who fell on this part of the Western Front It provides comprehensive details of gallantry awards and citations and describes many minor operations raids and other actions as well as the events that took place in April and May 1917 It is the story of warfare on the Western Front as illustrated through the lives of those who fought and died on the battlefields of Arras There are many unsung heroes and personal tragedies including a young man who went out into no man's land to rescue his brother an uncle and nephew killed by the same shell a suicide in the trenches and a young soldier killed by a random shell whilst celebrating his birthday with his comrades There is an unexpected connection to Ulster dating back to the days of Oliver Cromwell and William of Orange a link to Sinn Féin and an assassination a descendant of Sir Isaac Newton as well as a conjuror a friend of P G Wodehouse a young officer said to have been thrilled to lead his platoon into the trenches for the first time only to be killed three hours later and a man whose headstone still awaits the addition of his Military Medal after almost a century despite having been involved in one of the most daring rescues of the war This is a superb reference guide for anyone visiting Arras and its battlefields **Yorkshire VCs** Alan Whitworth, 2012-10-24 Today the Victoria Cross remains the supreme British award for bravery It takes precedence over all other awards and decorations During its 160 year history since the first

of these medals were given for gallantry during the Crimean War in the 1850 s 1 357 have been won and no less than 69 of them have gone to Yorkshiremen Alan Whitworth in this carefully researched and revealing account describes in graphic detail the exploits and the lives of this elite group of heroes **Jack Youll VC, Great War Hero** Paul Chrystal, Nina Youll, 2025-11-30 John Jack Scott Youll June 1897 27 October 1918 was a colliery electrician from a small village near Hartlepool County Durham before volunteering for the Army in 1915 Joining 1st Battalion Northumberland Fusiliers he showed early promise and was selected for officer training He first saw action on the Western Front and was mentioned in dispatches for his conduct during the heavy fighting around Polygon Wood in the Third Battle of Ypres But it was after redeployment to Italy that he earned the Victoria Cross for his exceptional valour and leadership near Asiago during the Third Battle of the Piave The medal citation for 2nd Lieutenant Youll describes how throughout the fighting his complete disregard of personal safety and very gallant leading set a magnificent example to all This was during an extended action which included his single handedly charging an Austrian machine gun post that had his unit pinned down killing most of the crew and turning the weapon on the enemy Tragically Lieutenant Youll VC was killed soon after during the Battle of Vittorio Veneto the final battle of the Italian campaign just twenty four hours before the ceasefire on this front and a mere fortnight before the end of the wider war Jack Youll s example of dutiful service leadership and courage has hitherto received little recognition beyond a dignified graveyard memorial in his hometown This well researched and detailed account written by his relative Nina Youll and historian Paul Chrystal provides at last a fitting testimonial to a true hero of the Great War
