The word has different interpretations in different societies throughout the world while the United Nations General Assembly has not sought to reach a definition beyond that implied in the title of the UN Declaration on the Rights of Persons belonging to National or Ethnic Religious and Linguistic Minorities adopted in December 1992 Minority Rights Group focuses its work on non dominant ethnic religious and linguistic communities whether or not they are numerical minorities.
