The Arts and the Christian Life Earl Davey, 2022-05-09 Many find their engagement with works of art raises questions concerning where value is found and how meaning and import are understood and experienced For persons of Christian faith a parallel question arises concerning the significance such experience holds for the Christian life and the spiritual journey This collection of essays pursues questions that address how we perceive value in our experience of the arts how this experience leads to a greater measure of human fullness and what significance engagement with the arts holds for the Christian life The author argues that human experience and the quality of our personhood are enriched in and through the imaginative life and that our spiritual lives are

profoundly impacted by our aesthetic engagements. An underlying assumption is that all great art, all that is beautiful, is inherently religious; that it embodies qualities that reflect the glory of God and is therefore valuable to the Christian life and one's spiritual experience. Indeed, insofar as the noetic privileges language and reason, the arts and the domain of the aesthetic provide an alternate pathway by which we are able to encounter the Divine.

Women on Philosophy of Art Alison Stone, 2024-08-14. *Women on Philosophy of Art* is the first study of women's philosophies of art in long nineteenth-century Britain. It looks at seven women spanning the time from the Enlightenment to the beginning of modernism. They are Anna Barbauld, Joanna Baillie, Harriet Martineau, Anna Jameson, Frances Power Cobbe, Emilia Dilke, and Vernon Lee. The central issue that concerned them was how art related to morality and religion. Baillie and Martineau treated art as an agency of moral instruction, whereas Dilke and Lee argued that art must be made for beauty's sake. Barbauld, Jameson, and Cobbe thought that beauty and religion were linked, while other women believed that art and religion must be decoupled. Other topics explored are gender and genius, tragedy, literary realism, why we enjoy the sufferings of fictional characters, the hierarchy of the art forms, whether art can transcend its historical circumstances, and critical issues around the artistic canon. Examining the print culture that made these women's interventions possible, this book shows that these women were doing a particular kind of philosophy of art, which was interdisciplinary and closely tied to artistic criticism and practice. The book traces how these seven women influenced one another as well as engaging with their male contemporaries. But unlike their male interlocutors, these women have been unjustly left out of narratives about the history of aesthetics. By including these women, we can enrich and broaden our understanding of the history of philosophy of art.

God's Beauty-in-Act Stephen M. Garrett, 2013-07-24. Jürgen Moltmann and others contend that Christian theology and the church face a dual crisis: one of relevance and the other of identity. Despite making this pronouncement nearly forty years ago, the church in the West continues to struggle with this crisis. Several proposals have been espoused, from the way of wisdom to the way of ecclesial praxis. Yet little attention is given in Protestant theological discourse to the role God's beauty plays in bringing theology and ethics together. By neglecting God's beauty for theological discourse, we risk diminishing Christian worship, witness, and wisdom. *God's Beauty in Act* addresses these issues in part by arguing that the redemptive, creative, suffering, and glorious resurrection of Christ are the nexus of God's being, beauty, and Christian living. God's beauty, understood as the fittingness of the incarnate Son's actions in the Spirit to the Father's will, radiates God's glory and draws perceivers into the dramatic movements of God's triune life. These movements serve as the patterns that shape the imagination, enabling participants to perform their parts creatively and fittingly in God's drama of redemption. In doing so, human beings flourish as they jettison false identities and realities of their own making that are incommensurate with God's purpose found in Christ by the Spirit.

Sacred and Profane Beauty Gerardus Leeuw, 2006. Gerardus van der Leeuw was one of the first to attempt a rapprochement between theology and the arts, and his influence continues to be felt in what is now a burgeoning field. *Sacred*

and Profane is the fullest expression of his pursuit of a theological aesthetics surveying religion's relationship to all the arts: dance, drama, literature, painting, sculpture, architecture, and music. This edition makes this seminal work first published in Dutch in 1932 newly available. A new foreword by Diane Apostolos Cappadona analyzes the continuing relevance of van der Leeuw's thought. Van der Leeuw's impassioned and brilliant investigation of the relationship between the holy and the beautiful is founded upon the conviction that for too long the religious have failed to seriously contemplate the beautiful, associating it as they do with the kingdom of sensuality and impermanence. Similarly, it has been alien to literati and aesthetes to reflect upon the holy for they choose to consider this physical world to be permanent and therefore to be glorified through beauty alone. In truth, as van der Leeuw undertakes to show in *Sacred and Profane Beauty*, the holy has never been absent from the arts, and the arts have never been unresponsive to the holy. Whether one considers the Homeric epics, the dancing Sivas, and Vedic poems, the sacred wall paintings of ancient Egypt, the primitive mask, or the range of sacred arts developed out of Latin and Byzantine Christianity, primordial creation in the arts was always directed toward the symbolization and interpretation of the holy. The fact that in our day this original connection is obscured and the artistic impulse is more generally regarded as wholly individualistic and autonomous does not contradict van der Leeuw's thesis; indeed, the breakdown of the unity of the holy and the arts is central to his thesis. Van der Leeuw was the rare thinker who combined profundity of insight, grace of style, and a willingness to take daring intellectual chances. In *Sacred and Profane*, he describes each of the arts in its original unity with the religious and then analyzes its historical disjunction and alienation. After a penetrating investigation of the structural elements within the arts, which illumines a crucial dimension of the religious experience, van der Leeuw points toward the reemergence of an appropriate theological aesthetics on which a reunification of the arts could be founded.

Theological Aesthetics Richard Viladesau, 1999. This book explores the role of aesthetic experience in our perception and understanding of the holy. Richard Viladesau's goal is to articulate a theology of revelation examined in relation to three principal dimensions of the aesthetic realm: feeling and imagination, beauty or taste, and the arts. After briefly considering ways in which theology itself can be imaginative or beautiful, Viladesau concentrates on the theological significance of aesthetic data provided by each of the three major spheres.

of aesthetic perception and response Throughout the work the underlying question is how each of these spheres serves as a source however ambiguous of revelation Although he frames much of his argument in terms of Catholic theology from the Church Fathers to Karl Rahner Hans Urs von Balthasar Bernard Lonergan and David Tracy Viladesau also makes extensive use of ideas from the Protestant theologian of the arts Gerardus van der Leeuw and draws insights from such diverse thinkers as Hans Goerg Gadamer Wolfhart Pannenberg and Iris Murdoch His analysis is enlivened by the artistic examples he selects the music of Mozart as contemplated by Karl Barth Schoenberg's opera *Moses und Aron* the sculptures of Chartres Cathedral poems by Rilke and Michelangelo and many others What emerges from this study is what Viladesau terms a transcendental theology of aesthetics In Thomistic terms he finds that beauty is not only a perfection but a transcendental That is any instance of beauty rightly perceived and rightly understood can be seen to imply divinely beautiful things as well In other words Viladesau argues God is the absolute and necessary condition for the possibility of beauty

A Revitalization of Images Gregory C. An Anthropological Defense of God Lloyd E. Sandelands, 2017-09-08 Anthropology the study of man is unlike every other study because humans are its subject And because we are its subject we cannot manage the philosophic and emotional distance necessary to see clearly Unable to stand apart from ourselves to comprehend our own truth we are compelled to assume things about ourselves that we cannot prove In a word anthropology begins in faith Lloyd Sandelands approaches the anthropological quest for God by comparing the faiths of modern social science and of the Christian church Sandelands describes the social scientific faith articulated by Hume Kant Rousseau Schopenhauer among others as an imagined state of nature that sees the individual as solitary self-sufficient and contented By contrast the Christian faith unites us as male and female persons in one flesh before God The challenge in the author's view is to decide which faith to build our lives upon
