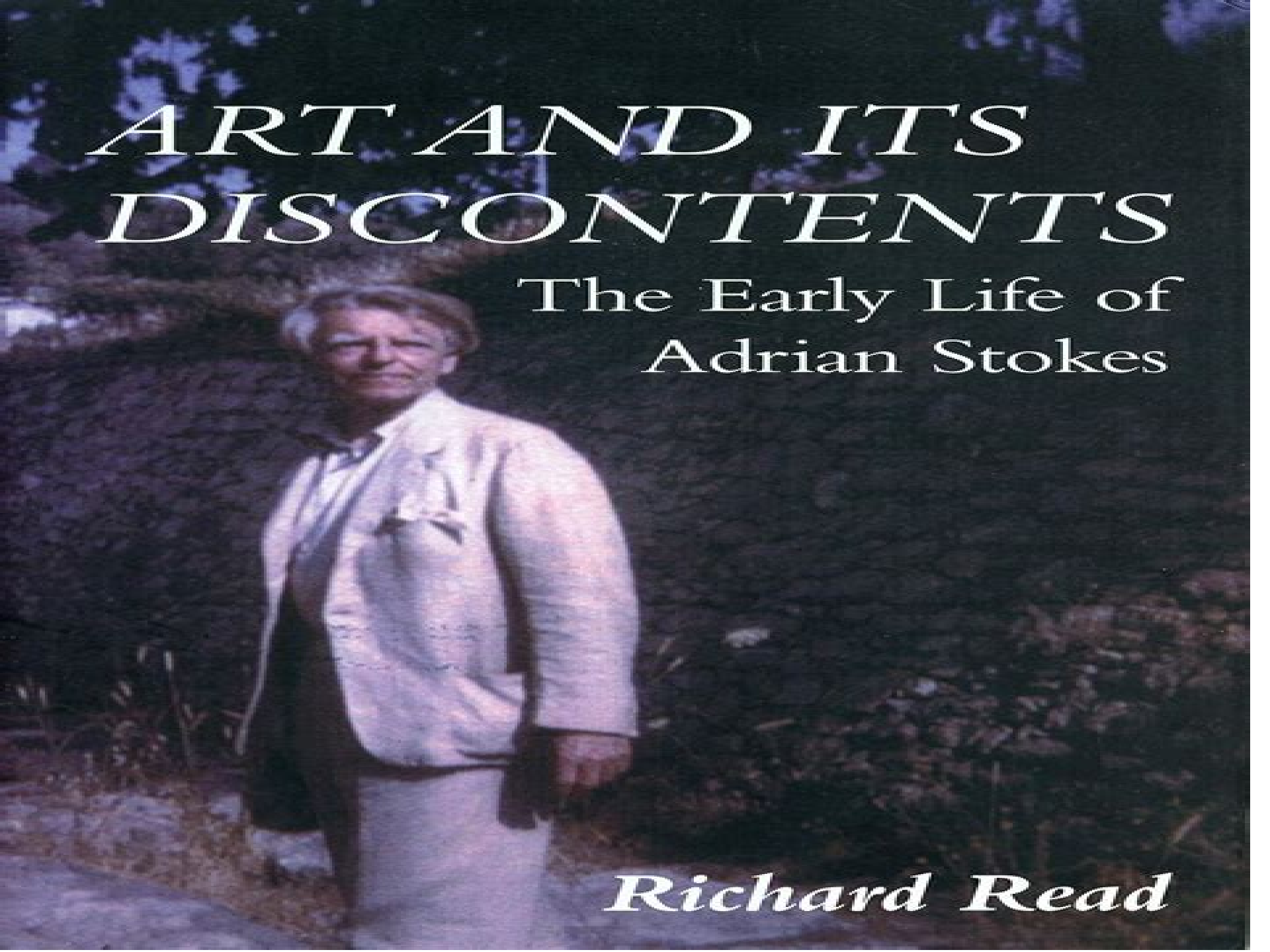

Art and Its Discontents Richard Read, 2002 Adrian Stokes is considered to have been one of the most original English art critics of the 20th century This study traces his development as a critic mainly up to his early reviews of Hepworth Nicholson and Moore

Art and Its Discontents Richard Read, 2017 This title was first published in 2002 Adrian Stokes 1902 1972 wrote some of the most engaging and provocative art criticism of the twentieth century He was a prolific author publishing books on the Renaissance among them *The Quattro Cento* and *Stones of Rimini* recently reissued on ballet and on the work of contemporary Modernist artists Stokes entered psychoanalysis with Melanie Klein in 1929 in an attempt to resolve some of the quandaries of his own complex sexual identity and corrosive self consciousness In later life he gained a significant reputation as a poet and painter Stokes's work emerged from a rich dialogue between the legacy of Ruskin and Pater and intense engagement with the Italian Renaissance the writings and art of of the European Modernists including friends such as Ezra Pound Barbara Hepworth and Ben Nicholson and psychoanalytic theory In this the first sustained examination of the writings Richard Read investigates how Adrian Stokes's work transformed English aesthetics when he became the first critical writer in Britain convincingly to relate psychoanalytic theory to art Provided by publisher

Adrian Stokes Stephen Kite, 2017-12-02 Adrian Stokes 1902 72 aesthete critic painter and poet is among the most original and creative writers on art of the twentieth century He was the author of over twenty critical books and numerous papers for example the remarkable series of books published in the 1930s *The Quattro Cento* 1932 *Stones of Rimini* 1934 and *Colour and Form* 1937 that embraced Mediterranean culture and modernity His criticism extends the evocative English aesthetic tradition of Walter Pater and John Ruskin into the present endowed by a stern sensibility to the consolations offered by art and architecture and the insights that psychoanalysis affords Indeed for Stokes architecture provides the entree into art and this book is the first study to comprehensively examine Stokes's theory of art from a specifically architectonic perspective The volume explores the crucial experiences through which this architectonic awareness evolved traces the influence upon Stokes of places texts and personalities and examines how his theory of art developed and matured The argument is supported by appropriate illustrations to confirm the evidence that Stokes's claim for architecture as mother of the arts carries the deepest experiential and psychological import

artworks sit at the heart of a book that examines Ehrenzweig's working relationships with important British artists such as Bridget Riley Eduardo Paolozzi and other members of the Independent Group in London in the 1950s and 1960s In Ehrenzweig's second book *The Hidden Order of Art* 1967 his thinking on Jackson Pollock is important too It was this book that inspired American artists Robert Rauschenberg and Robert Morris when they deployed his concept of de-differentiation Here Williamson offers new readings of process art c 1970 showing how Ehrenzweig's aesthetic retains relevance beyond the immediate post war era

Portrait of a Life Roger Amos, 2019-07-26 Melanie Klein was a Viennese psychoanalyst who extended the work of Sigmund Freud in significant and innovative ways She lived and worked in the UK from 1926 until her death in 1959 During her life she was a controversial and divisive figure and has remained so since her death conflict between the Freudian and Kleinian strands of psychoanalysis dominated the history of psychoanalysis in the latter half of the twentieth century The reasons why she polarised opinion are multiple and complex partly they were related to her psychoanalytic ideas and how she expressed them but they were also intrinsic to her personality In 2016 a pair of delicate low relief sculptures of Melanie Klein in profile were re-discovered having been hidden away for some eighty years and have been subsequently identified as the work of the sculptor Oscar Nemon Roger Amos was asked to write a brief

article about these sculptures for publication on the Melanie Klein Trust website During his research he discovered that Klein had destroyed two significant works of art depicting herself one a bust by the same sculptor as the low relief profiles Oscar Nemon and the other a portrait by William Coldstream This beautifully illustrated book is the first comprehensive review of all attempts to portray Klein during her lifetime from her earliest childhood until her old age including the work of painters sculptors and portrait photographers It reviews the history of each artistic project and the relationship between Klein and the artist involved locating them in a narrative of Klein s life The complex and interrelated reasons why she chose to destroy some of the representations of herself but kept others are identified and discussed Through an understanding of the subject artist relationship Amos illuminates Klein s professional life in the world of psychoanalysis A must read for all scholars and professionals working in the field of psychoanalysis psychotherapy and psychodynamic counselling plus those with an interest in Melanie Klein or aesthetics this enjoyable read shines a never before seen light on to the world of Melanie Klein
