Palacios,1996 Social Security Privatization Jan Walliser,1999 Data in Society Jeff Evans,Sally Ruane,Humphrey Southall,2019-08-21 Statistical data and evidence based claims are increasingly central to our everyday lives Critically examining Big Data this book charts the recent explosion in sources of data including those precipitated by global developments and technological change It sets out changes and controversies related to data harvesting and construction dissemination and data analytics by a range of private governmental and social organisations in multiple settings Analysing the power of data to shape political debate the presentation of ideas to us by the media and issues surrounding data ownership and access the authors suggest how data can be used to uncover injustices and to advance social progress **Radical Inequalities** Nara Dillon,2020-05-11 The Chinese Communist welfare state was established with the goal of eradicating income inequality But paradoxically it actually widened the income gap undermining one of the most important objectives of Mao Zedong s revolution Nara Dillon traces the origins of the Chinese welfare state from the 1940s through the 1960s when such inequalities emerged and were institutionalized to uncover the reasons why the state failed to achieve this goal Using newly available archival sources Dillon focuses on the contradictory role played by labor in the development of the Chinese welfare state At first the mobilization of labor helped found a welfare state but soon labor s privileges turned into obstacles to the expansion of welfare to cover more of the poor Under the tight economic constraints of the time small temporary differences evolved into large entrenched inequalities Placing these developments in the context of the globalization of the welfare state Dillon focuses on the mismatch between welfare policies originally designed for European economies and the very different conditions found in revolutionary China Because most developing countries faced similar constraints the Chinese case provides insight into the development of narrow unequal welfare states across much of the developing world in the postwar period Early Retirement Patterns in Europe Trudie Schils,2005 The research in this dissertation is targeted at revealing the similarities and differences in European early retirement institutions including unemployment and disability schemes In addition using longitudinal data from a large number of European countries the determinants of early retirement decisions are analysed empirically and the role played by institutions is surveyed This research shows that both less tight entitlement conditions and high generosity of early retirement schemes exert a disincentive effect on staying in work for the older worker Back page *Publications Update* World Bank,1996

Robin Blackburn, 2020-05-05 Banking on Death offers a panoramic view of the history and future of pension provision A work of unique scope it traces the origins and development of the pension idea from the days of the French Revolution to the troubles of the modern welfare state As we live longer employers are closing their pension schemes and many claim that public treasuries will not be able to cope with the retirement of the babyboomers Banking on Death analyses the challenge facing public schemes and the malfunctioning of private retirement provision concluding with a bold proposal for how to pay for decent pensions for all Robin Blackburn argues that pension funds have been depleted by wasteful promotion and used as gambling chips by ruthless and overpaid top executives This is the world of grey capitalism where employees savings are sequestered from them and pressed into the service of corporate aggrandisement Even the best companies find it hard to run a business and a pension fund at the same time especially when the latter is larger than the former The fund managers notorious short termism and herd instinct and their failure to curb the greed and irresponsibility of the corporate elite lead to obscene inequalities and a blighted social landscape The pension privatisation lobby Blackburn shows has lost major battles in France and Germany the United States and Italy because of the popular fears it evokes And the case for privatisation looks intellectually threadbare after withering critiques from such notable theorists as Joseph Stiglitz and Pierre Bourdieu Banking on Death shows that pensions are political dynamite and have undone governments from France and Italy to Argentina Popular outcries led Reagan Clinton and Blair to change tack will this happen to George W Bush too Blackburn argues that the ageing society will generate increased costs but so long as the new life course is properly financed all age groups will gain He proposes a public regime of asset based welfare drawing on the ideas of John Maynard Keynes and Rudolf Meidner that could ensure secondary pensions for all and foster a more responsible egalitarian and humane pattern of economic development Keeping the Promise of Social Security in Latin America
