Axiomatic Utility Theory under Risk Ulrich Schmidt, 2012-12-06 The first attempts to develop a utility theory for choice situations under risk were undertaken by Cramer 1728 and Bernoulli 1738 Considering the famous St Petersburg Paradox a lottery with an infinite expected monetary value Bernoulli 1738 p 209 observed that most people would not spend a significant amount of money to engage in that gamble To account for this observation Bernoulli 1738 pp 199 201 proposed that the expected monetary value has to be replaced by the expected utility moral expectation as the relevant criterion for decision making under risk However Bernoulli's 2 argument and particularly his choice of a logarithmic utility function seem to be rather arbitrary since they are based entirely on intuitively 3 appealing examples Not until two centuries later did von Neumann and Morgenstern 1947 prove that if the preferences of the decision maker satisfy certain assumptions they can be represented by the expected value of a real valued utility function defined on the set of consequences Despite the identical mathematical form of expected utility the theory of von Neumann and Morgenstern and Bernoulli's approach have however IFor comprehensive discussions of this paradox cf Menger 1934 Samuelson 1960 1977 Shapley 1977a Aumann 1977 Jorland 1987 and Zaretskii 1987 2Cramer 1728 p 212 on the other hand proposed that the utility of an amount of money is given by the square root of this amount

Schoemaker, 2013-11-11 In this valuable book Paul Schoemaker summarizes recent experimental and field research that he and others have undertaken regarding the descriptive validity of expected utility theory as a model of choice under uncertainty His principal message is that this paradigm is too narrow in its conception and misses some of the important elements of a descriptive model of individual choice In particular Schoemaker calls attention to the importance of individual differences task effects and context effects as they influence behavior The expected utility hypothesis has come under scrutiny in recent years from a number of different quarters This book brings together these many studies and relates them to the large body of literature on individual decision making under risk Although this paradigm may be appropriate for describing behavior under many conditions of uncertainty Schoemaker presents convincing evidence that it does not do well with respect to protection against low probability events For example he shows that the insurance purchase decision is influenced by the way information is presented to the client as well as by the statistical knowledge of the respondents

hypothesis is that behaviour can be represented as the maximization of a suitably restricted utility function. This hypothesis lies at the heart of a large body of recent work in economics of course but also in political science, ethics and other major branches of the social sciences. Though this hypothesis of utility maximization deserves our continued respect, finding further refinements and developing new critiques remain areas of active research. In fact many fundamental conceptual problems remain unsettled. Where others have been resolved, their resolutions may be too recent to have achieved widespread understanding among social scientists. Behavioral Decision Theory Kazuhisa Takemura, 2021-09-29. This book is the second edition of *Behavioral Decision Theory* published in 2014. The main approach and structure of this book have been retained in the new edition. However, this second edition provides a fresh overview of the idea of behavioral decision theory and related research findings such as theoretical and empirical discoveries of preference formation, time discounting, social interaction and social decision making. The book covers a wide range from classical to relatively recent major studies concerning behavioral decision theory, which in brief is a general term for descriptive theories to explain the psychological knowledge related to people's decision making behavior. It is called a theory but is actually a combination of various psychological theories for which no axiomatic systems such as those associated with the utility theory widely used in economics have been established. The utility theory is often limited to qualitative knowledge; however, as the studies of Nobel laureates H. A. Simon, D. Kahneman and R. Thaler have suggested, the psychological methodology and knowledge of behavioral decision theory have been applied widely in such fields as economics, business administration and engineering and are expected to become even more useful in the future. Research into people's decision making represents an important part in those fields, various aspects of which overlap with the scope of behavioral decision theory. This theory is closely related to behavioral economics and behavioral finance, which have come into greater use in recent years. This book will appeal especially to graduate students, advanced undergraduate students and researchers who are interested in decision making phenomena.

Affective Decision Making Under Uncertainty Donald J. Brown, 2020-12-18. This book is an exploration of the ubiquity of ambiguity in decision making under uncertainty. It presents various essays on behavioral economics and behavioral finance that draw on the theory of Black Swans (Taleb 2010) which argues for a distinction between unprecedented

events in our past and unpredictable events in our future The defining property of Black Swan random events is that they are unpredictable i.e. highly unlikely random events In this text Mandelbrot's 1972 operational definition of risky random unpredictable events is extended to Black Swan assets assets for which the cumulative probability distribution or conditional probability distribution of random future asset returns is a power distribution Ambiguous assets are assets for which the uncertainties of future returns are not risks Consequently there are two disjoint classes of Black Swan assets Risky Black Swan assets and Ambiguous Black Swan assets a new class of ambiguous assets with unpredictable random future outcomes The text is divided into two parts the first of which focuses on affective moods introduces affective utility functions and discusses the ambiguity of Black Swans The second part which shifts the spotlight to affective equilibrium in asset markets features chapters on affective portfolio analysis and Walrasian and Gorman Polar Form Equilibrium Inequalities In order to gain the most from the book readers should have completed the standard introductory graduate courses on microeconomics behavioral finance and convex optimization The book is intended for advanced undergraduates graduate students and post docs specializing in economic theory experimental economics finance mathematics computer science or data analysis
