Gene action now can often be elucidated by studying the pathway from gene to phenotype following positional cloning rather than working in the opposite direction as was customarily done before the tools of new genetics were available. In an increasing number of genetic diseases the pathogenic mechanisms have been elucidated with positive consequences for prevention and treatment. It therefore became necessary to rewrite almost completely major portions of this book. These developments are now making genetics arguably the leading basic science for medicine as well as a recognized medical speciality. But all these changes do not mean that the entire framework of human genetics had to be reconstructed.
