Rosenstein challenges this claim showing how Rome reconciled the needs of war and agriculture throughout the middle republic The key Rosenstein argues lies in recognizing the critical role of family formation By analyzing models of families needs for agricultural labor over their life cycles he shows that families often had a surplus of manpower to meet the demands of military conscription Did then Roman imperialism play any role in the social crisis of the later second century B C Rosenstein argues that Roman warfare had critical demographic consequences that have gone unrecognized by previous historians heavy military mortality paradoxically helped sustain a dramatic increase in the birthrate ultimately leading to overpopulation and landlessness
