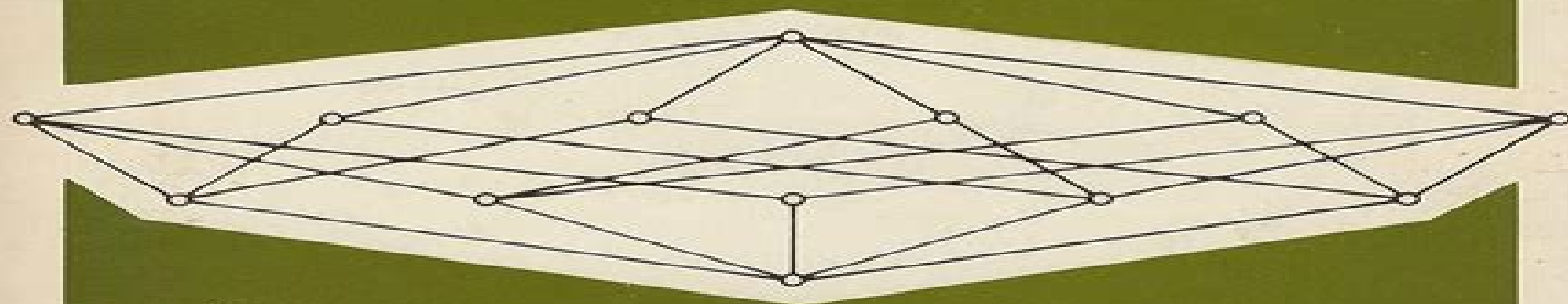

Blyth, 2005-11-24 The notion of an order plays an important role not only throughout mathematics but also in adjacent disciplines such as logic and computer science The purpose of the present text is to provide a basic introduction to the theory of ordered structures Taken as a whole the material is mainly designed for a postgraduate course However since prerequisites are minimal selected parts of it may easily be considered suitable to broaden the horizon of the advanced undergraduate Indeed this has been the author's practice over many years A basic tool in analysis is the notion of a continuous function namely a mapping which has the property that the inverse image of an open set is an open set In the theory of ordered sets there is the corresponding concept of a residuated mapping this being a mapping which has the property that the inverse image of a principal down set is a principal down set It comes the fore as no surprise that residuated mappings are important as far as ordered structures are concerned Indeed albeit beyond the scope of the present position the naturality of residuated mappings can perhaps best be exhibited using categorical concepts If we regard an ordered set as a small category then an order preserving mapping $f: A \rightarrow B$ becomes a functor Then f is residuated if and only if

there exists a functor $f: B \rightarrow A$ such that $f \circ f^*$ is an adjoint pair

Rota, 1987-01-01 The present volume of reprints are what I consider to be my most interesting and influential papers on algebra and topology To tie them together and to place them in context I have supplemented them by a series of brief essays sketching their historical background as I see it In addition to these I have listed some subsequent papers by others which have further developed some of my key ideas The papers on universal algebra lattice theory and general topology collected in the present volume concern ideas which have become familiar to all working mathematicians It may be helpful to make them readily accessible in one volume I have tried in the introduction to each part to state the most significant features of each paper reprinted there and to indicate later developments The background that shaped and stimulated my early work on universal algebra lattice theory and topology may be of some interest As a Harvard undergraduate in 1928-32 I was encouraged to do independent reading and to write an original thesis My tutorial reading included de la Vallée Poussin's beautiful *Cours d'Analyse Infinitésimale* Hausdorff's *Grundzüge der Mengenlehre* and Fréchet's *Espaces Abstraits* In addition I discovered Carathéodory's 1912 paper *Vber das lineare Mass von Punktmengen* and Hausdorff's 1919 paper on *Dimension und Ausseres Mass* and derived much inspiration from them A fragment of my thesis analyzing axiom systems for separable metrizable spaces was later published 2 This background led to the work summarized in Part IV

Lattices, Semigroups, and Universal Algebra Jorge Almeida, Gabriela Bordalo, Philip Dwinger, 2013-11-11 This volume contains papers which for the most part are based on talks given at an international conference on Lattices Semigroups and Universal Algebra that was held in Lisbon Portugal during the week of June 20-24 1988 The conference was dedicated to the memory of Professor Antonio Almeida Costa a Portuguese mathematician who greatly contributed to the development of the algebra in Portugal on the 10 anniversary of his death The themes of the conference reflect some of his research interests and those of his students The purpose of the conference was to gather leading experts in Lattices Semigroups and Universal Algebra and to promote a discussion of recent developments and trends in these areas All three fields have grown rapidly during the last few decades with varying degrees of interaction Lattice theory and Universal Algebra have historically evolved alongside with a large overlap between the groups of researchers in the two fields More recently techniques and ideas of these theories have been used extensively in the theory of semigroups Conversely some developments in that area may inspire further developments in Universal Algebra On the other hand techniques of semigroup theory have naturally been employed in the study of semilattices Several papers in this volume elaborate on these interactions

Freeze,Jaroslav Ježek,James Bryant Nation,1995 A thorough treatment of free lattices including such aspects as Whitman s solution to the word problem bounded monomorphisms and related concepts totally atomic elements infinite intervals computation term rewrite systems and varieties Includes several results that are new or have not been previously published Annotation copyright by Book News Inc Portland OR Residuated Lattices: An Algebraic Glimpse at Substructural Logics Nikolaos Galatos,Peter Jipsen,Tomasz Kowalski,Hiroakira Ono,2007-04-25 The book is meant to serve two purposes The first and more obvious one is to present state of the art results in algebraic research into residuated structures related to substructural logics The second less obvious but equally important is to provide a reasonably gentle introduction to algebraic logic At the beginning the second objective is predominant Thus in the first few chapters the reader will find a primer of universal algebra for logicians a crash course in nonclassical logics for algebraists an introduction to residuated structures an outline of Gentzen style calculi as well as some tidbits of proof theory the celebrated Hauptsatz or cut elimination theorem among them These lead naturally to a discussion of interconnections between logic and algebra where we try to demonstrate how they form two sides of the same coin We envisage that the initial chapters could be used as a textbook for a graduate course perhaps entitled Algebra and Substructural Logics As the book progresses the first objective gains predominance over the second Although the precise point of equilibrium would be difficult to specify it is safe to say that we enter the technical part with the discussion of various completions of residuated structures These include Dedekind McNeille completions and canonical extensions Completions are used later in investigating several finiteness properties such as the finite model property generation of varieties by their finite members and finite embeddability The algebraic analysis of cut elimination that follows also takes recourse to completions Decidability of logics equational and quasi equational theories comes next where we show how proof theoretical methods like cut elimination are preferable for small logics theories but semantic tools like Rabin s theorem work better for big ones Then we turn to Glivenko s theorem which says that a formula is an intuitionistic tautology if and only if its double negation is a classical one We generalise it to the substructural setting identifying for each substructural logic its Glivenko equivalence class with smallest and largest element This is also where we begin investigating lattices of logics and varieties rather than particular examples We continue in this vein by presenting a number of results concerning minimal varieties maximal logics A typical theorem there says that for some given well known variety its subvariety lattice has precisely such and such number of minimal members where values for such and such include but are not limited to continuum countably many and two In the last two chapters we focus on the lattice of varieties corresponding to logics without contraction In one we prove a negative result that there are no nontrivial splittings in that variety In the other we prove a positive one that semisimple varieties coincide with discriminator ones Within the second more technical part of the book another transition process may be traced Namely we begin with logically inclined

technicalities and end with algebraically inclined ones Here perhaps algebraic rendering of Glivenko theorems marks the equilibrium point at least in the sense that finiteness properties decidability and Glivenko theorems are of clear interest to logicians whereas semisimplicity and discriminator varieties are universal algebra par excellence It is for the reader to judge whether we succeeded in weaving these threads into a seamless fabric

A Primer of Subquasivariety Lattices Kira Adaricheva, Jennifer Hyndman, J. B. Nation, Joy N. Nishida, 2022-08-18 This book addresses Birkhoff and Malcev's problem of describing subquasivariety lattices The text begins by developing the basics of atomic theories and implicational theories in languages that may or may not contain equality Subquasivariety lattices are represented as lattices of closed algebraic subsets of a lattice with operators which yields new restrictions on the equaclosure operator As an application of this new approach it is shown that completely distributive lattices with a dually compact least element are subquasivariety lattices The book contains many examples to illustrate these principles as well as open problems Ultimately this new approach gives readers a set of tools to investigate classes of lattices that can be represented as subquasivariety lattices

A Compendium of Continuous Lattices G. Gierz, K. H. Hofmann, K. Keimel, J. D. Lawson, M. Mislove, D. S. Scott, 2012-12-06 A mathematics book with six authors is perhaps a rare enough occurrence to make a reader ask how such a collaboration came about We begin therefore with a few words on how we were brought to the subject over a ten year period during part of which time we did not all know each other We do not intend to write here the history of continuous lattices but rather to explain our own personal involvement History in a more proper sense is provided by the bibliography and the notes following the sections of the book as well as by many remarks in the text A coherent discussion of the content and motivation of the whole study is reserved for the introduction In October of 1969 Dana Scott was lead by problems of semantics for computer languages to consider more closely partially ordered structures of function spaces The idea of using partial orderings to correspond to spaces of partially defined functions and functionals had appeared several times earlier in recursive function theory however there had not been very sustained interest in structures of continuous functionals These were the ones Scott saw that he needed His first insight was to see that in more modern terminology the category of algebraic lattices and the so called Scott continuous functions is cartesian closed
