Basic Features of Government of India Act 1935

1. *Creation of All India Federation (Provincial Autonomy)*

- **Provincial Autonomy:** Autonomy to provinces was given effect by dividing legislative and executive powers between the Provinces and the Centre.
- The Provinces were under the executive authority of Governor appointed by the Crown. Governor exercised the powers on the advice of Ministers, who were in turn responsible to Provincial legislature.
- Governor was given discretion to carry out certain functions, without being bound by Ministerial advice, subject to the control of the Governor- General.

2. *Division of Power*

- **Federal List:** 59 subjects, under the authority of Central Legislature, currency, armed forces etc.
- **Provincial List:** 54 subjects, under the authority of Provincial Legislature, education, public health etc.
- **Concurrent List:** 36 subjects, under the authority of both Central and Provincial Legislature, marriage, criminal law, civil law etc.
- **Residuary Powers:** Viceroy

3. *Dyarchy Abolished only at provincial level. (double rule)*
